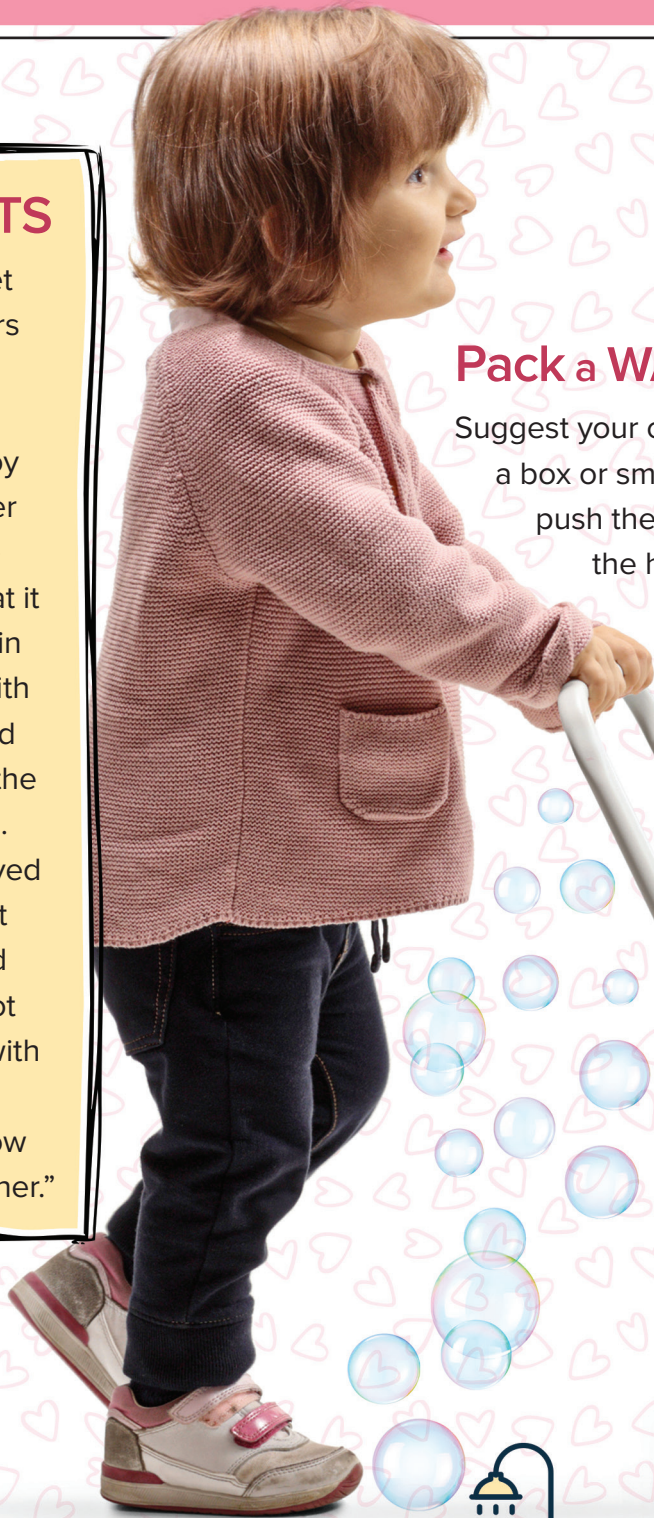
Show love to others.

ROMANS 12:10

Build TENTS

Use a large sheet and several chairs to build a tent. Encourage your child to gather toy animals and other toys to put in the tent. Suggest that it is very crowded in the tent. Work with your child to build another tent for the animals and toys. Say: "Abram moved his family when it was too crowded so they would not quarrel or fight with Lot's family. The Bible says to show love to one another."

Pack a WAGON or BOX

Suggest your child pack her favorite things in a box or small wagon. Encourage her to push the box or pull the wagon through the house. Ask your child to choose a place to unpack her things. Tell the Bible story (reverse side). Mention that Abram moved his family away from Lot's family when it was too crowded. Say that Abram showed love so the family would get along.



BABIES

Enjoy BATH TIME Fun

Provide some animal bath toys as you bathe your baby. Explain that in the Bible Abram and Lot had a lot of animals to feed. Tell the Bible story (reverse side). Show one of

the animals. Make that animal sound together. Talk about how families show love to one another. Enjoy bath time fun together with the animals.

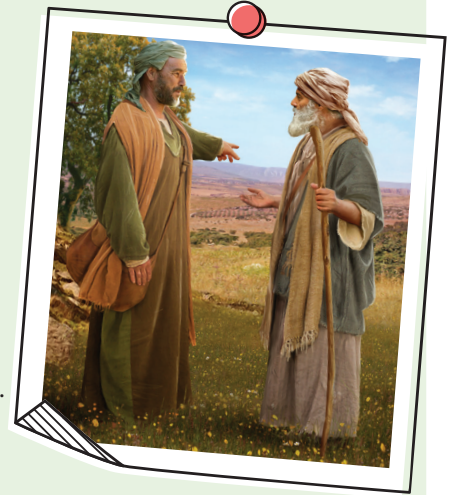

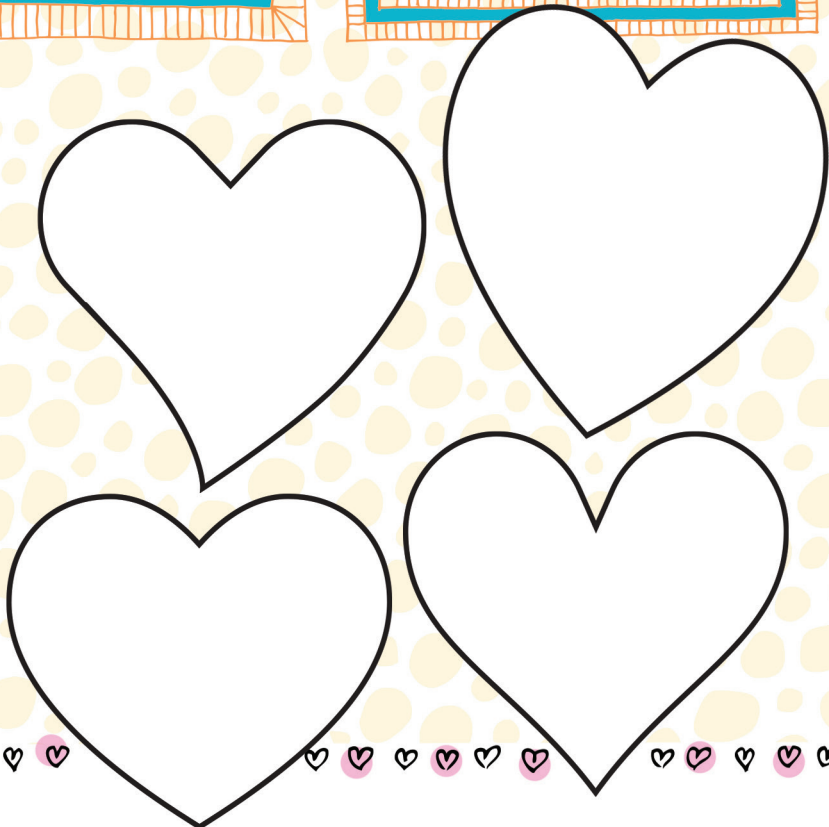

Abram Solved a Quarrel

BASED ON GENESIS 13

WEEKLY VERSE: Show love to one another. *Romans 12:10*

LIFE POINT: Family members can choose to work together and get along.

Abram had a large family and many animals. He had helpers to take care of his animals. Abram was Lot's uncle. Lot had many animals, too. Lot also had helpers to care for his animals.

Lot's helpers began arguing with Abram's helpers. There was not enough grass and water for all the animals.

Abram heard the helpers fighting. He knew it was wrong for the helpers to be arguing. Abram knew that God wants families to get along and work together. Abram decided to talk to Lot.

Abram told Lot to choose the land where he wanted to live. Abram said that he would take the other land. This way they would both have plenty of grass for their animals.

Abram Solved a Quarrel

GENESIS 13

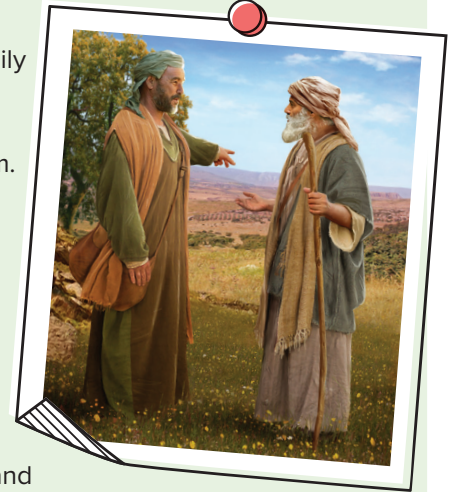
God commanded Abram to leave his family and go to a place God would show him. (Genesis 12:1) Abram had no sons of his own, so he took his nephew, Lot, with him.

God blessed Abram and Lot—each of them had many cattle, sheep, servants, and tents. But there was not enough land or water for Abram and Lot to stay together. Abram’s workers and Lot’s workers began to argue.

Abram told Lot, “Please! Let there be no quarreling between us or between our workers. We are family. Look at the land and choose where you would like to be. If you go to the left, I’ll go to the right. If you go to the right, I’ll go to the left.”

Lot looked out and saw a good piece of land with plenty of water. He chose it for himself and moved away from Abram.

After Lot was gone, God made a promise to Abram. God said, “Look north, south, east, and west. I will give you and your family all of the land you see. I will make your family so large that you won’t be able to count your offspring—they will be like the dust of the earth!” Abram trusted God. Abram moved his tents and flocks and servants to a place called Hebron (HEE bruhn), where he built an altar to worship God.



THE BIBLE MEETS LIFE

This Bible story shows how family members honor God when they get along with one another. Abram’s workers and Lot’s workers argued over the land and water. Abram gave Lot the first choice and solved the problem.

LIVE IT OUT

Discuss with your child: “What are the benefits of getting along in our family? What could happen if I always get my way? How can you help the members of our family get along?” Help your child think about answers to these questions.
