Play Out the BIBLE STORY

Spread two towels on the floor with the narrow ends touching as a pretend sea. Tell the Bible story (reverse side). Fold the edges of the touching towels back, pretending the water is separated. Invite your child to walk across the sea on the dry land. Return the towels to touching. Comment that the Israelites crossed the Red Sea because God made a way. Only God can cause the sea to dry up like that. God can do all things.



SCOOP and POUR Water

Place this page in a ziplock bag and put the bag in the bottom of a plastic tub.

Fill the tub with about 2 inches of water.

Provide measuring cups and funnels for your child to use to scoop and pour.

Mention that God parted the Red Sea so the Israelites could cross on dry land. Show the Bible story picture (reverse side). Say: "That is something only God can do. No one is like God."



PLAY in Water

Place some bath toys and toy people figures in the water (small tub or during bath). Demonstrate how to move toys through the water. Tell the Bible story (reverse side). Say that God helps people in many ways. Enjoy splashing and moving toys in the water together.

They stopped near the Red Sea to rest.


Pharaoh changed his mind after the people left. He wanted them to come back and work for him again.

God led Moses and the people around toward the Red Sea.


God led them with a cloud during the day and a fire to give light at night. Once they reached the Red Sea, God told Moses to tell the people to camp.



When everyone was across, God told Moses to stretch his hand out again. This time the sea flowed back together. God had saved His people. The people were amazed at what God had done!










CONVERSATION

The Israelites at the Red Sea

EXODUS 13:17-22; 14

When Pharaoh let the Israelites leave Egypt, God led them toward the Red Sea. The people followed a pillar of cloud during the day and a pillar of fire during the night so they would know which way to go. They camped near the Red Sea, surrounded by mountains and water.

When Pharaoh realized that the Israelites really had left, he changed his mind and decided to go after them. He took 600 of his best chariots and



Pharaoh got close, the Israelites saw him and his army approaching. They were scared because they were trapped. But Moses said, "Don't be afraid. The Lord will fight for us."

God told Moses to lift his staff and stretch out his hand over the Red Sea. Moses obeyed and stretched out his hand over the waters. God pushed the waters back with a powerful wind and turned the sea into dry land. When the waters divided, the Israelites walked through on dry ground with a wall of water on their right and their left.

All of Pharaoh's horses, chariots, and officers chased after the Israelites and went into the dry bed of the sea. God told Moses to stretch his hand out over the sea again so the sea would return to normal. Moses obeyed. As he stretched his hand out over the sea, all the water rushed back in and covered the horses, chariots, and officers. No one from Pharaoh's army lived.

When the Israelites saw the great power of God, they trusted God and believed in Him.
