

God Protected Daniel



LOOK at Lion Pictures

Locate pictures of lions in books or on an electronic device. Guide your child to point to the lion's eyes, teeth, paws, and tail. Ask your child to roar like a lion very loudly. Continue asking him to roar more and more softly until he is almost whispering. Mention that Daniel obeyed God and prayed only to Him. Remind your child that God

helped Daniel and kept him safe. State: "God loves you and helps you."

TALK About Prayer


Look at the Bible story picture (reverse side). Mention that Daniel prayed only to God and that God helped him and kept him safe. Say: "Praying is talking to God. You can talk to God just like Daniel did." Encourage your child to think about what he would like to pray about. Give him an opportunity to pray. State: "You can pray to God anytime and anyplace. God loves us and helps us."

PRAY Together

Use opportunities throughout the day to pray and thank God (before meals, for food, for clothes, for trees, for family members, etc.). Use short sentence prayers as you pray together. Explain that praying is talking to God. Mention that Daniel loved God and prayed to Him.

WEEKLY VERSE: God is our helper. Psalm 46:1

LIFE POINT: God loves and helps people.

Some people looked for ways to get Daniel in trouble with the king. These mean people got the king to sign a new law that said


everyone had to pray to the king and no one else.

Daniel heard about the law. He chose to obey God and pray to Him. The men told the king that Daniel prayed to God and not the king.


The king put Daniel in a den of lions!

LIFE POINT: God loves and helps people.


Daniel was a good man who did what God wanted him to do. King Darius (duh


RIGH uhs) planned to put Daniel in charge of all the land. The other leaders did not like this. The men went to the king and told him to make a new law (rule) that would not let anyone worship or pray to God. Anyone who broke this law would be put in the lions' den.

Daniel heard the law, but he knew that the right thing was to worship and pray to God. Daniel chose to continue praying to God. The other leaders told the king about Daniel. The king was sad, but he knew that Daniel had to go into the lions' den. "May your God protect you," the king said to Daniel.

Daniel was put into the lions' den. The king did not sleep all night because he was worried about Daniel. The next morning, King Darius rushed to the lions' den and called out to Daniel. Daniel said, "God sent an angel to shut the lions' mouths. They did not hurt me."

King Darius was happy that Daniel was safe! The king wrote a law for all people to obey God.





THE BIBLE MEETS LIFE


LIVE IT OUT




Daniel in the Lions' Den

DANIEL 6

King Darius (duh RIGH uhs) chose 120 princes throughout his kingdom. He also chose 3 presidents to watch over the princes. He chose Daniel as 1 of his presidents. Daniel was trustworthy and honest, and the king planned to put him in charge of his whole kingdom.

The other leaders were jealous. They watched for Daniel to do something wrong so they could complain to the king. Soon, they realized that they would never find anything against Daniel unless it had something to do with his God. The



leaders went to the king and said, "You should make a law that says for 30 days no one may pray to any god or man except you. If someone breaks the law, he should be thrown into the lions' den!" King Darius agreed and made the law.

When Daniel heard about the law, he went into his house, opened his window that faced Jerusalem, and got down on his knees. Then he prayed to God, three times each day, just as he had always done.

The leaders searched for Daniel and found him praying to God. They hurried to the king and said, "Daniel has ignored you, the king. He prays three times each day to his God." The leaders insisted that the king throw Daniel into the lions' den.

The king was upset, but the law could not be changed. As Daniel was thrown into the den, King Darius said, "May the God you serve rescue you!" A large stone was placed over the opening, and the king sealed the stone with his ring.

The king could not sleep all night. The next morning he hurried to the lions' den and called to Daniel. Daniel was alive and safe! He said, "God sent an angel and shut the lions' mouths. They haven't hurt me."

King Darius was overjoyed and gave orders to take Daniel out of the lions' den. The king wrote a new law that people in his kingdom should worship Daniel's God because He is the living God and He rescued Daniel from the lions.
