VERSE

God sent Jesus. -ISAIAH 7:14



LOOK in a MIRROR

Use a nonbreakable handheld mirror or stand in front of a large mirror. Gently touch your child's nose and say: "Before you were born, I wondered what your nose would look like. I couldn't wait to see you." Comment that God sent an angel to tell Mary she was going to have a special baby. Challenge your child to touch her nose, ears, mouth, and eyes.

Be a HELPER

Place this paper on the floor and cover it with a washcloth. Invite your child to look under the washcloth. Guide your child to notice the Bible story picture and briefly tell the Bible story. Mention that Mary said, "I am God's helper, I will do what God says." Wet the washcloth and invite your child to be a helper by wiping down the front of the fridge or cleaning off a chair. Thank your child for helping.

S & Look at FAMILY PICTURES

Gather family pictures to show your baby. Include pictures of grandparents, aunts and uncles, and cousins. Snuggle with your baby and identify the people in each picture. Comment: "We have such a special family. God gave Jesus a family, too. Mary was Jesus' mommy and Joseph was His daddy."



Angels told Mary and Joseph that God planned for them to be Jesus' family. Mary and Joseph did what God wanted them to do. Jesus starts with the letter J.









Angels Visited Mary and Joseph

LUKE 1:26-38: MATTHEW 1:18-24

One day God sent the angel Gabriel to visit a young virgin named Mary. She was engaged to be married to a man named Joseph, who came from the family of David. The angel had some incredible news for Mary.

"Greetings! You are a favored woman. God is with you," announced Gabriel. Mary was frightened and wondered what kind of greeting this might be.

"Don't be afraid, Mary," said Gabriel. "God has chosen you to have a son, and you will call Him Jesus. He will be great and will be called Son of the Most High. He will be a great King who will reign forever."

Mary was confused. She asked, "How can this be?"

Gabriel explained, "The Holy Spirit will make this possible. The child will be called the Son of God." Then Gabriel had another surprise for Mary. He told her that her relative, Elizabeth, would have a baby, too, even though Elizabeth was old. Gabriel reminded Mary that nothing is impossible with God.
