

#### Saul Taught About Jesus

WEEKLY VERSE: Saul spoke boldly

**LIFE POINT:** People can choose to

obey Jesus.

Before Saul believed in Jesus, he wanted to hurt people who loved and obeyed Jesus.




One day while traveling, Saul saw a bright light and fell to the ground. He heard Jesus' voice saying, "Saul, why do you hurt me?" The voice told Saul to get up and go to Damascus (duh MASS kuhs). When he got up, Saul could not see.

Saul's friends took him to the city. For three days he was blind. God told a man named Ananias (an uh NIGH uhs) to go to Saul. Ananias placed his hands on Saul, and at once Saul was able to see.

Saul changed and believed that Jesus was God's Son. He wanted others to believe in Jesus, too.

Saul was with Jesus' disciples in Damascus. He was telling people that Jesus was God's Son. The people who heard Saul knew he had hurt people who believed in Jesus. They were afraid of him, but Saul kept telling people about Jesus.





### CONVERSATION

# Jesus Gave the Great Commission

#### **MATTHEW 28:16-20**

Jesus gave His disciples some instructions. After He rose from the dead, He told the women who saw Him, "Go tell My disciples to go to Galilee. They will see Me there." (Matthew 28:10)

Jesus' disciples followed His instructions. They went to a mountain

in Galilee, just as Jesus had told them to. When Jesus came to meet them, some of the disciples worshiped Him. But some of them still doubted Him.

Jesus gave His disciples a commission—an important set of orders to follow. He said, "I have been given power and authority over everything in heaven and on earth. So go! Make disciples (followers of Me) in every nation. Baptize them in the name of the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit. Teach these new disciples to obey all the commandments I have given you."

Jesus made His disciples a promise, "Remember, I am with you always—even to the end of the world!"

**WEEKLY BIBLE VERSE:** Acts 5:32

**LIFE POINT:** God sends the Holy Spirit to help believers tell others about Jesus.


#### THE BIBLE MEETS LIFE

Your child discovered that God sends the Holy Spirit to help believers tell others about Jesus. Before Jesus went back to heaven, He commanded His disciples to spread the gospel.



#### LIVE IT OUT

Review the Bible story. Find Matthew 28:19-20 and read it with your child. Explain that in this passage Jesus reminds His disciples to tell about Him. Remind your child that the Holy Spirit helps Christians tell people the good news of Jesus.
