TOUCH the **Table**

Challenge your toddler to find a table in your house. Help him to gently pat the table. Comment that the couple in the Bible story (reverse side) helped Elisha by preparing a place for him to stay. Challenge your toddler to find a lamp (pointing only), chair, and bed.



MAKE a Tent

Invite your child to help you make a simple tent with chairs and blankets. Talk about the Bible story as you build. Mention that a couple made a room for Elisha to stay in. Sit with your child inside the tent.

Look at the Bible story picture (reverse side) together. Comment that the couple helped Elisha. Talk about ways your family can help someone else.

Play with your baby and some of his favorite toys. Ask your baby to help clean up. Tell the Bible story (reverse side) about friends who helped take care of Elisha as you clean together. Thank your baby for helping you clean up the toys!

Elisha wanted a way to thank the couple. He told the woman that she would have a baby boy.




A man named Elisha often visited a town called Shunem (SHOO nem). A woman and her husband became friends with Elisha. They asked him to eat at their house.

LIVE IT OUT

Review the Bible story with your child. Say the Bible verse, "Give to God's people when they need it. Romans 12:13." Talk about ways you can help people in need. Elisha was a prophet of God. A prophet told people what God wanted them to know. Elisha walked from town to town, telling people about God's love. When Elisha came to a town, he often felt tired and hungry. He needed a place to eat and sleep.

Elisha often went to a town called Shunem (SHOO nem). Every time Elisha went to Shunem, he ate a meal at the home of a man and his wife who lived in the town. The wife told Elisha that he could eat and sleep at their house when he came to Shunem.

One day the woman said to her husband, "Elisha helps people know about God. Let us build a room for Elisha. He can stay here when he comes to town." The couple built the room on the roof of their house. Inside the room they placed a bed, table, lamp, and chair.

When Elisha returned to Shunem, the couple showed him the room. Now Elisha had a special place to rest when he came to town. Elisha was thankful.






A Couple Helped Elisha

2 KINGS 4:8-17

A woman from Shunem (SHOO nem) offered the prophet Elisha food when he came to her town. Elisha began to stop at the woman's house whenever he passed by.

The woman said to her husband, "Elisha is a man of God. Let's make a room for him upstairs.

We can put a bed, a table, a chair, and a lamp in the room. It will be his place to stay whenever he comes."

One day when Elisha was staying in his upstairs room, he sent his servant to get the woman. "You've gone to so much trouble for us. What can we do for you?" he asked. When the woman did not ask for any favors, Elisha asked his servant Gehazi (gih HAY zigh), "What should be done for her?"

Gehazi suggested, "Well, she has no son. Her husband is old." Elisha told the woman, "At this time next year, you will hold your son in your arms!"

Just as Elisha said, the woman had a son.

Missionaries are Christians called by God to tell another group of people the good news about Jesus.


