Jesus Told a Story About a Kind Man



VISIT a FRIEND

Show the Bible story picture (reverse side). Tell the Bible story. Let your child color a picture for a sick friend, and then visit or mail him the picture. Pray for the friend as you travel to his house or mail the picture. Mention that we can be kind to others like the kind man in the Bible story.



DONATE a NEW TOY

Take your child to choose a new toy to donate to a local children's hospital or other area location that helps sick children. Take your child with you to deliver the toy. Retell the Bible story (reverse side) on your way to the hospital. Pray for the child who will receive the gift.

BABIES

READ a Favorite BOOK

Let your baby hold a doll or toy animal as you tell the Bible story (reverse side). Mention that the man was kind and helped the hurt man. Remind your baby that we can be kind to others as well. Say that Jesus taught people by telling stories. We learn when we read stories. Read a favorite book to your baby.

THE BIBLE MEETS LIFE

BABIES

Jesus told a story about a man who got hurt as he walked along a road.

The first two men who came by did not help him.

The third man, a man from the country of Samaria, helped the hurt man.

The third man was kind to the hurt man.

Jesus told a story about a man who traveled down a road. People hurt the man and took his money. They left the man lying on the side of the road.

Two men saw the hurt man, but they did not stop to help.

Finally, one man stopped. This man was from the country of Samaria. He was kind to and helped the hurt man.

2s

Jesus told a story about a man who walked on a road to another town. Some people stopped the man. The people hurt him, tore his clothes, and took his money. They left him on the side of the road.

Two different men saw the hurt man but did not stop to help.

A third man saw the hurt man. This man was from the country of Samaria. The man was kind and stopped to help. He bandaged the hurt man and helped the man get on his animal to ride to an inn.

The kind man paid for the hurt man to have the care he needed until he came back to the inn.

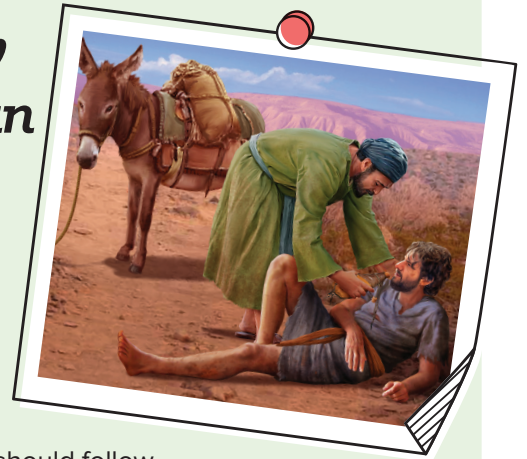
CONVERSATION

Jesus Told a Story About a Kind Man

BASED ON LUKE 10:25-37

WEEKLY VERSE: Jesus taught many things with parables and stories. *Mark 4:2*

LIFE POINT: Jesus taught people by telling parables (stories).



A man asked Jesus what rules he should follow to go to heaven. Jesus said, “You should love God and love your neighbor.”

The man asked, “Who is my neighbor?”

Jesus told a parable (a story that teaches something) to answer him. He said, “A man walked down the road. Robbers hurt him and took his money. They left him by the road.

“A man who worked at the temple came by and saw the hurt man. He crossed the road and walked by without helping. Another man, a church leader, came down the road. He did not help the hurt man either.

“Later, a man from Samaria walked by. He stopped to help. The Samaritan bandaged the hurt man. He placed him on his donkey and took him to an inn. He took care of the hurt man. The next day, the kind man gave the owner of the inn money to take care of the hurt man until he was well again.”

After the story, Jesus asked, “Which of the three men treated the hurt man like a neighbor?”

The man said, “The one who helped the hurt man.”

Jesus said, “Go and help others like the kind man did.”

CONVERSATION

Jesus Told the Parable of the Good Samaritan

LUKE 10:25-37

One day an expert in the law asked Jesus what he had to do to inherit eternal life. “What have you read?” Jesus asked.

The expert answered, “Love the Lord your God with all your heart, with all your soul, with all your strength, and with all your mind, and love your neighbor as yourself.”

“You are right. Do those things,” Jesus said.

But the man knew these things were hard to do, so he asked another question, “Who is my neighbor?”

To help him understand, Jesus told him a story, “A man was going from Jerusalem to Jericho when robbers attacked him. They took everything he had, beat him, and ran away, leaving the man lying by the road. A priest came down the road, but when he saw the man, he crossed to the other side of the road and kept going.

Next, a Levite (a temple helper) traveled on the road. The Levite crossed to the other side of the road and passed by the injured man, too.

Finally, a Samaritan man came by. When he saw the man, he felt sad for him and went to help him. The Samaritan bandaged the injured man’s wounds, put him on his own animal, and took the man to an inn. The Samaritan man stayed all night and took care of him. The next day the Samaritan gave the innkeeper some money and said, “Please take care of this man. When I come back this way, I will pay you for whatever extra you spend on his care.”

After Jesus told the story, He turned to the man who was an expert in the law. Jesus asked, “Now which one of these men was a neighbor to the man who was robbed?”

The expert said, “The one who showed kindness to him.”

“You are right,” said Jesus. “Now go and do the same.”
