Jesus Healed a Man Born Blind

UNIT VERSE

God sent His only
Son, Jesus.

1 JOHN 4:9

DIG in the DIRT

Dig in the dirt with your child. Show the Bible story picture (reverse side) as you tell the Bible story. Consider making mud pies together for extra fun.

BABIES

Play PEEKABOO

Play Peekaboo with your baby. Say: "I see you!" each time you and your baby see each other. Tell your baby that Jesus healed a man who could not see. Remind him that the man told everyone that Jesus made him well. Pray with your baby, thanking God for eyes to see.

READ the BIBLE

Read the Bible story (reverse side) with your child. Show the same Bible story in a children's picture Bible. Suggest your child close his eyes for a few minutes. Talk about what he sees (nothing, darkness) and hears (noises). Tell your child to open his eyes. Remark that Jesus healed people, which means He made them well. Say that in the Bible story, Jesus made the man to see.

WEEKLY VERSE: Jesus made sick people well. *Luke 7:21*

LIFE POINT: Jesus healed people (made people well).



THE BIBLE MEETS LIFE

The Bible story taught that Jesus healed people (made people well). Jesus healed a man who was born blind to show the power of God.

LIVE IT OUT

Provide a toy doctor kit for your child to play with. Encourage her to doctor a doll or toy animal. Comment that doctors help people when they are sick, but Jesus healed people. Jesus made people well, or to walk, or to see.

 Jesus told the man to go wash his eyes in the pool of Siloam (sigh LOH uhm). He did and returned able to see!
 People were surprised that the man could see. They knew him to be blind since he was born. He told the people that Jesus made his eyes to see.
