People were surprised that the man could see. They asked, "Are you the man who was blind and was a beggar? What happened?"


The man said, "I am the man who was born blind. Jesus put mud on my eyes. He told me to wash my eyes in the Pool of Siloam. Jesus healed me."


Some leaders were angry. They did not believe that Jesus could heal a man who was blind. The man told them again, "Jesus healed me."


They asked the man's parents, "Is this your son?"

# CONVERSATION

## Jesus Healed a Man Born Blind

#### JOHN 9

Jesus and His disciples were walking when they passed a man who had been blind since birth. The disciples asked Jesus, "Was this man born blind because he sinned or because his parents sinned?"

Jesus answered, "No one's sin caused his blindness. This happened so people could see God's power at work." Jesus told the disciples that He came into the world to do the work of His Father who sent Him.

Then Jesus spit on the ground, made some clay from the spit and the dirt, and spread the clay on the blind man's eyes. "Go wash your eyes in the Pool of Siloam," Jesus said to the blind man. The man left and washed in the pool. When he came back, he could see for the first time!

Everyone wondered how the man could suddenly see. His neighbors asked, "Isn't this the same man who used to sit and beg because he was blind?" Other people thought he was not the blind man.

The man kept saying, "I'm the one! I'm the one who was born blind! Jesus made clay, placed it on my eyes, and told me to wash in the Pool of Siloam. I went and washed, and now I can see!"

The people brought the man to the Pharisees, who were religious leaders. The leaders asked him how he was now able to see. Again, the man told the story of how Jesus had healed him. The Pharisees were angry. They said, "This man can't be from God! He has sinned by doing this on the Sabbath!" The religious leaders called for the parents of the man who was healed. "How did this happen?" the leaders demanded to know.

The man's parents simply replied, "We don't know. All we know is that our son who was blind can see now. Ask him what happened!"

Again, the once blind man was brought to the leaders. The Pharisees ordered him to name who had healed him. The healed man said, "All I know is that I was blind, but now I see. If this man were not from God, He would not be able to do anything." The Pharisees were so angry that they threw out the healed man.

When Jesus heard they threw the man out of the synagogue, Jesus found him. The man believed in Jesus and worshiped Him.
