

Jesus Fed a Crowd

Bake BREAD

Invite your child to "help" bake bread (refrigerated bread sticks or follow a recipe) for your family. Talk about the Bible story (reverse side) as the bread rises and bakes. Remind your child that even though there was not much bread at first, Jesus prayed and made it enough to feed many people.




Gather FOOD Items

Gather food items to donate to a local food pantry or ministry organization. Read aloud the Bible story (reverse side) to your baby. Say: "Jesus knew the people were hungry. Jesus

helped the people because He loved them." Place the items in your vehicle. Say to your child: "We can help others, too. Let's pray for the people who will eat this food." Thank God that you can help others.

LIFE POINT: Jesus helps people because He loves them.





Many people heard Jesus teach. Jesus wanted to help the people by feeding them.

One of Jesus' helpers brought Him a boy's lunch of five loaves of bread and two fish.

Jesus prayed and thanked God for the food.

The helpers gave all of the people food to eat. There were even leftovers.



Many people went to see Jesus and hear Him teach. Mothers, fathers, and children were hungry.

A boy gave his food to Jesus.

Jesus thanked God for the food.

Jesus' helpers gave food to all the people.



Many people followed Jesus to a mountainside to hear Him teach. Jesus saw all of the people coming toward Him.

Jesus asked His helper Philip, "Where can we buy bread for all these people to eat?"

Jesus' helper Andrew said, "I saw a boy who has some bread and fish, but that is not enough to feed all these people."

Jesus took the food and thanked God for it. Then the helpers gave the people bread and fish. Everyone had food to eat.

Jesus told His helpers to pick up the food that was left over. They filled 12 baskets with bread!

to see how many baskets of leftovers there were.









(helpers) were sitting on a mountainside. Many people followed them. The people had heard about Jesus. They knew Jesus helped people.




Andrew, another one of Jesus' disciples, saw a little boy with five small loaves of bread and two fish. Andrew told Jesus about the boy's fish and bread.

Jesus told His disciples, "Tell the people to sit down." All of the people sat on the ground. Jesus took the five loaves of bread and two fish. Jesus thanked God for them. Then Jesus broke the bread and fish into pieces to give to the people.

The people ate as much food as they wanted. Then Jesus told His disciples, "Gather the leftover bread and fish." They filled baskets with food. There were 12 baskets of leftover food. Jesus had fed many hungry people!

Jesus Healed the Sick

MATTHEW 8:1-15

Large crowds of people followed Jesus wherever He went. A man with leprosy (a serious skin disease) knelt before Jesus and worshiped Him.

"Lord, if You are willing, You can heal me and make me clean," the man said.

Jesus touched the man with the

skin disease and answered, "I am willing! Be clean!" Immediately, the man's skin was well! Jesus told the man to take an offering and show the priests that he was well.

When Jesus entered the city of Capernaum, a centurion, an important officer in the Roman army, stopped Jesus, too. "Lord, my servant is lying paralyzed at home. He is sick and in great pain!"

"I will come and heal him," Jesus said.

The centurion answered, "Lord, I am not worthy for You to come to my house. I have soldiers under my command. When I say go, they go! When I say do this, they do it! You have great authority. Just say the word, and I know my servant will be well!"

Jesus was amazed at the centurion's words. He said, "I have not found anyone in Israel with faith so great! Go. You have believed, and it will be done." At that very moment, the servant was healed.

When Jesus went into Peter's house, He saw Peter's mother-in-law lying in bed with a fever. Jesus touched her hand, and the fever left her. Then she got up and began to serve Him.
