VERSE


Jesus helped people. **MATTHEW 14:14**

PLAY in Water

Take two drinking straws to bath time, one for you and one for your child. Bring any toy boats as well. Show your child how to make waves by blowing air through the straw. Talk about the Bible story (reverse side). Mention that Jesus made the waves be still by speaking. Challenge your child to be still in the bath to make the water completely still.

VISIT a Body of Water

Visit a pond, lake, or any body of water near your home. Observe and point out plant and animal life. Talk about the Bible story (reverse side). Make the point that God is in control of everything your child sees. Challenge her to feel the wind and see the effects of it on the water. Explain that God can make the wind be still with the sound of His voice. Say a simple prayer thanking God for His power and beautiful creation.





BABIES

LISTEN to a Rain Tube

Make a rain tube: Wrap construction paper around a cardboard tube. Tape a square of paper over one end of the tube. Put a twisted cup dry rice to the tube. Tape another paper

square to the other end of the tube. Help your baby tilt the tube back and forth or roll on the floor to hear rain sounds. Read aloud the Bible story (reverse side). Say: "Jesus made the storm stop. Jesus is powerful."

BABIES

The men were afraid. They called to Jesus to help them.

Jesus awoke and told the storm to be quiet and still. The storm stopped.



Jesus had taught people about God. He told His helpers (disciples), "Let's go to the other side of the lake."

They got into a boat and began to sail across the lake. Jesus fell asleep on a cushion in the boat.

Suddenly a great wind began to blow. The wind blew so hard that waves of water splashed into the boat. The helpers were frightened! They thought the boat would sink. The men woke up Jesus and cried out for help.

Jesus stood up and said, "Be quiet! Be still!" Immediately the wind stopped blowing, and the waves became calm.





WEEKLY VERSE: The wind and the sea obey Jesus. *Matthew 8:27*

LIFE POINT: Jesus is powerful.

One day a large crowd of people had gathered near the lake. Jesus

sat in a boat and spoke to them. The people sat on the shore and listened to many stories that helped them learn about God.

Late that afternoon, Jesus said to His disciples (helpers), "Let's go across the lake." They left the crowd and sailed toward the other side. Jesus went to the back of the boat so He could rest. He went to sleep on a cushion.

While Jesus was sleeping, a big storm came up. Wind and waves rocked the boat. Water splashed into the boat. The disciples were afraid. They called, "Jesus! Wake up! We're in danger!"

Jesus stood up. He told the wind to stop blowing and the waves to be still. The wind stopped! The waves became calm and still! The disciples were surprised that Jesus had stopped the storm.

CONVERSATION

Jesus Calmed the Storm

MARK 4:35-41

A large crowd of people stood on shore and listened to Jesus teach while He sat in a boat. (Mark 4:1) Later that evening, Jesus told His disciples, "Let's cross over to the other side of the sea." Jesus was already in the boat, so they sailed away from the crowd.



Before the boat reached the

other shore, a fierce storm pounded the boat.

Waves rolled and crashed over the sides of the rocking boat.

Where was Jesus? In the back of the boat, sleeping on a pillow! The disciples were scared! They woke Jesus and said, "Teacher! Don't You care that we are going to die?"

Jesus got up and spoke sharply to the roaring wind and violent sea. "Peace! Be still!" The wind stopped. The waves dropped. The sea was still and calm.

Looking at His disciples, Jesus asked, "Why are you afraid? How is it that you have no faith?"

The disciples were in awe of Jesus. "Who is this?" they asked one another. "He commands the wind and the sea, and they obey Him!"
