

#### Jesus Made Bartimaeus Well

### Make a NATURE COLLAGE

Give your child a small container. Go on a nature walk together. Encourage your child to use her eyes to look for small nature items. Return home. Cut out of clear contact plastic two matching shape (square, circle. etc.). Place one shape sticky side up on a table. Help your child place the objects on the shape. Place the other shape sticky side down on top of the filled shape. Tape the collage on a window so the light can shine through. Tell the Bible story (reverse side). Say that before Jesus healed him, Bartimaeus could not see God's creation with his eyes. Say a simple prayer, thanking God for eyes to see.

## **Do MOVEMENTS**


Make simple movements for your baby to copy: blink your eyes, smile, frown, pull your ear, clap your hands, and touch your toes. Say: "God gives us eyes to see." Tell the Bible story. Say: "Bartimaeus was happy he could see."

## Play PEEKABOO

Hold up a small blanket before your child's face. Say: "Where is (child's name)?" Quickly drop the blanket. Say: "There you are!" Continue several times. Cover her eyes and say: "Bartimaeus could not see!" Remove the blanket and say: "Jesus made him well. He made him to see!" Repeat several times.

WEEKLY VERSE: Jesus made blind people see. *Luke 7:21* 

LIFE POINT: Jesus makes people well.





A man named Bartimaeus could not see; he was blind. He sat by the road. Bartimaeus heard Jesus walking by. He called out to Jesus. He asked Jesus to make him see. Jesus had Bartimaeus come to Him. Jesus made Bartimaeus able to see.



A man named Bartimaeus (BAHR tih MEE uhs) could not see. Bartimaeus sat by the road. He heard that Jesus was walking by. He called out to Jesus many times. Jesus had Bartimaeus come to Him.

Jesus asked what Bartimaeus wanted. He said he wanted to see. Jesus made Bartimaeus able to see because Bartimaeus believed Jesus could make him see.



As Jesus and His disciples (helpers) left the town of Jericho, a blind man—a man who could not see—called out to Jesus.

The blind man was named Bartimaeus.

People told him to be quiet. He kept calling out to Jesus.

Jesus had Bartimaeus come to Him.

Jesus asked Bartimaeus what he wanted. He said he wanted to see. Jesus made Bartimaeus able to see because Bartimaeus believed Jesus could make him see.


## Jesus Made Bartimaeus Well

#### **BASED ON MARK 10:46-52**

WEEKLY VERSE: Jesus made blind people see. *Luke 7:21* 

LIFE POINT: Jesus makes people well.

Jesus was walking outside the city of Jericho. His disciples (helpers) and a large crowd of people walked with Him.



A man named Bartimaeus (BAHR tih MEE uhs) was sitting by the road. He was blind. When he heard people walking by, he would ask them for money.

Bartimaeus heard a large crowd of people walking by. He heard that one of those people was Jesus. Bartimaeus began to shout, "Jesus, help me."


Many people told him to be quiet. But he yelled as loudly as he could, "Jesus, help me."


Jesus heard Bartimaeus and said, "Bring him to Me." The people told the man who was blind, "Get up. Jesus is calling you." Bartimaeus jumped up and went to Jesus.

Jesus asked him, "What do you want me to do for you?"

Bartimaeus answered, "I want to be able to see."

Jesus said to him, "You believe I can heal you. Now you can see." At once Bartimaeus could see. He was no longer blind. Jesus had healed him. As Jesus and the crowd began to walk again, Bartimaeus went with them.

This Bible story showed that Jesus has power over death because He is God's Son. Although Lazarus had been dead for four days, Jesus raised Him from the dead. At Jesus' command Lazarus came out of the grave!

## Jesus Raised Lazarus

#### JOHN 11:1-44

Lazarus was a friend of Jesus. Mary and Martha, Lazarus' sisters, sent Jesus a message, saying, "Lord, the one You love is sick."

Jesus did not go to Lazarus right away. He said, "This sickness will not end in death. It will be for the glory of God." Jesus stayed where He was for two more days.



At the end of two days, Jesus said, "Let's go to Judea."

The disciples worried. "The Jews tried to stone You—You are going there again?"

Jesus told them, "Lazarus is dead. I'm glad I wasn't there so that you may believe. Let us go to him." By the time Jesus arrived, Lazarus' body had been in a tomb for four days.

When Martha heard that Jesus was approaching, she went out and met Him, but Mary stayed at home. Martha said to Jesus, "Lord, if You had been here, my brother would not have died."

Jesus answered, "Your brother will rise again. I am the resurrection and the life. Everyone who believes in Me will never die—ever! Do you believe this, Martha?"

Martha replied, "I believe that You are the Christ, the Son of God." When Mary saw Jesus, she fell at His feet, weeping and saying to Him, "Lord, if You had been here, my brother would not have died." When Jesus saw Mary and others crying, He was moved in His spirit and also wept. The people could see how much Jesus loved this family.

Jesus went to the tomb where Lazarus' body had been buried. Jesus commanded that the stone in front of the tomb be taken away. He lifted up His eyes and prayed, "Father, thank You for hearing Me. May the people believe You sent Me." Then Jesus shouted, "Lazarus, come out!" Lazarus walked out of the tomb, still wrapped in his grave clothes. Jesus said, "Untie his grave clothes and let him go!"
