VERSE

Jesus came to
do God's work.
JOHN 6:38

TALK on TOY PHONES

Give your child a toy phone. Talk into another toy phone or pretend to talk on your cell phone to your child. Say into the phone: "Jesus is alive!" Encourage your child to repeat that after you. Tell the Bible story (reverse side). Say that we can tell everyone that Jesus is alive.

TELL a NEIGHBOR

Go for a walk around your neighborhood. Tell the Bible story (reverse side) as you walk. Remind your child that the women hurried to tell Jesus' friends that Jesus was alive. Visit a neighbor with your child. Encourage your child to tell the neighbor: "Happy Easter, Jesus is alive!"

Jesus died on the cross and was buried in a tomb, but what happened next? After three days, the stone was rolled away because Jesus is alive!



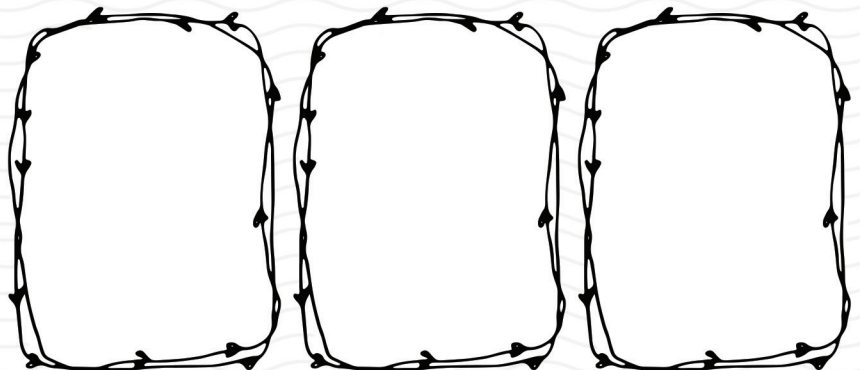

CONVERSATION

Jesus Is Alive

BASED ON MATTHEW 28:1-10

WEEKLY VERSE: Jesus is alive.
Matthew 28:7

LIFE POINT: Jesus is alive.

Jesus died on a cross and was buried in a tomb.

Three days later, Mary and Mary Magdalene walked sadly to the tomb where Jesus was buried. As they got near the tomb, the ground began to shake because an angel came from heaven.

The angel rolled back the large stone in front of the tomb and sat on the stone. The angel told the women, "Do not be afraid. I know you are looking for Jesus. I have good news! Jesus is not here. He is alive!"

The angel told the women to look in the tomb. Jesus was not there! Then the angel said, "Hurry and tell the disciples (helpers) that Jesus is not in the tomb! He is alive! Tell the disciples that Jesus will see them in Galilee."

The women were happy. They ran to find the disciples and tell them the good news. Just then, they saw Jesus! The two women ran to Jesus and worshiped Him.

Jesus said, "Tell My disciples to go to Galilee. They will see Me there." The women left quickly to tell the disciples all they had seen and heard.

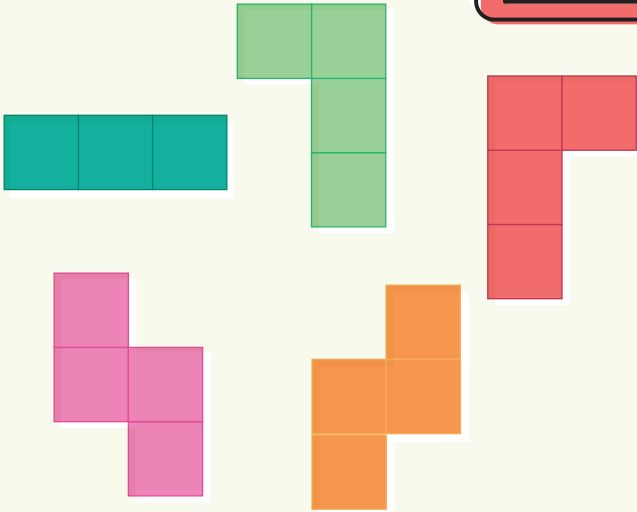
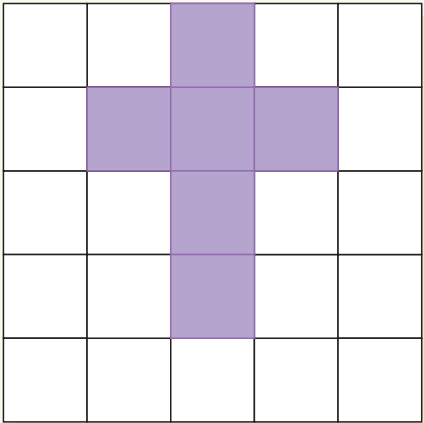
The ONLY Way

1 PETER 2:24



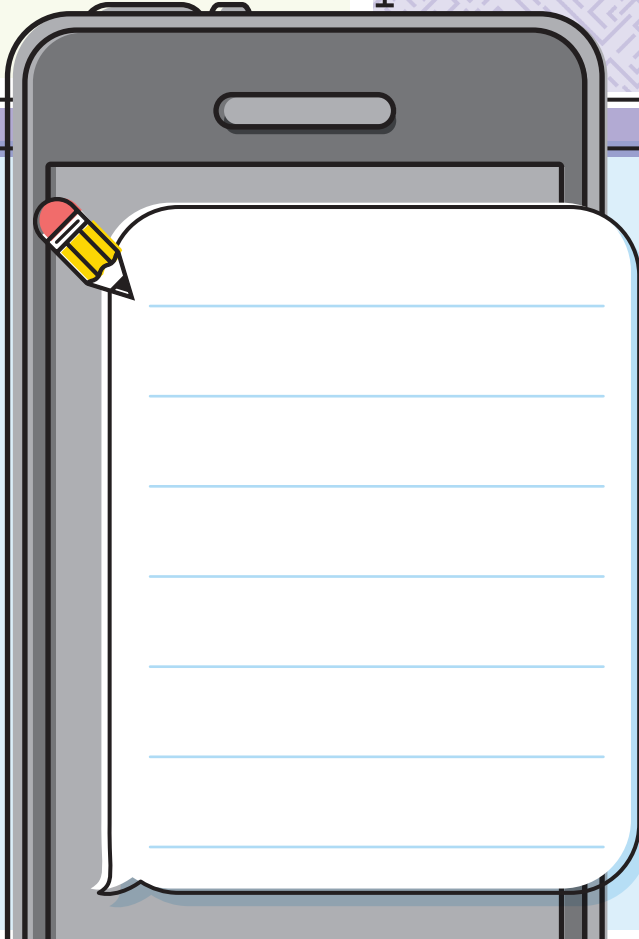

CONVERSATION

Jesus Was Crucified and Resurrected

MATTHEW 26:36–28:10

Jesus took His disciples to the garden of Gethsemane. He knew that He was about to die. Three times Jesus prayed, “Father, please let this cup pass from Me. Not My will but Your will be done.”

Suddenly, Judas, one of Jesus’ disciples, arrived with a large crowd carrying swords and clubs. Judas betrayed Jesus by kissing His cheek so the crowd would know who Jesus was. The men grabbed Jesus and arrested Him.

Jesus was taken to the high priest’s house. He accused Jesus of claiming to be God, a crime deserving death. The leaders mocked (made fun of) Jesus, and people told false stories about Him.

Peter, one of Jesus’ disciples, waited outside. “You were with Jesus,” some people said. Three times Peter said that he did not know Jesus.

The leaders took Jesus to Pilate, the governor. Pilate could not find that Jesus had done anything wrong. He tried to set Jesus free, but the crowds shouted, “Crucify Him!” Pilate agreed to put Jesus to death.

Soldiers beat Jesus, put a robe on Him, and placed a crown of sharp thorns on His head. They led Jesus to a place called Golgotha (which meant place of the skull) and nailed Him to a cross. From noon until three in the afternoon, darkness covered the land. Jesus cried out, “My God, My God, why have You forsaken (turned away from) Me?” Soon after, He shouted again with a loud voice, and then He died.

One of the guards said, “This man really was God’s Son!”

Jesus’ body was placed in a tomb. The entrance was covered with a heavy stone. Soldiers stood guard to stop people from taking Jesus’ body. But on the third day guards could not stop the earthquake that shook the ground or the angel who rolled back the stone. The guards were so afraid they dropped to the ground as if they were dead!

Some women had come to the tomb to care for Jesus’ body. The angel said, “He is not here! He is risen, just as He said! Come and see!”

As the women ran to tell Jesus’ disciples the news, Jesus met them. “Greetings!” Jesus said. The women fell at Jesus’ feet and worshiped Him. “Don’t be afraid,” Jesus told them, “Go tell My brothers they will see Me in Galilee.” Jesus is alive!

WEEKLY BIBLE VERSE: 1 Peter 2:24

LIFE POINT: Jesus took the punishment for people’s sins.



THE BIBLE MEETS LIFE

From this Bible story your child discovered that Jesus took the punishment for people’s sins. Jesus was crucified to pay the penalty for the sins of the world. He is the Savior whom God sent. Anyone can choose to believe in Him.

LIVE IT OUT

Review the Bible story and ask why Jesus had to die. Search online for Scriptures about sin. List as many sins as your family can think of and talk about how easy it is to sin. Read aloud Romans 6:23 and 1 Peter 2:24. Connect people’s sin to Jesus’ crucifixion. Give thanks for Jesus!
