





The First Church

BASED ON ACTS 2

WEEKLY VERSE: The people met together in the temple. *Acts 2:46*

LIFE POINT: People at church gather to learn about God and Jesus.

Peter and the other disciples (helpers) of Jesus were together in a house in Jerusalem. They heard a sound like a strong wind. People gathered outside the house after hearing the sound.




The disciples began to speak in different languages. They went out to tell the people about Jesus. The people were surprised that the disciples could speak in many languages.

Peter stood up and talked to all the people. "Listen to me," Peter said. "God did this. God sent His Son, Jesus. Jesus did many miracles. Jesus told us about God. He died but now Jesus is alive and is in heaven with God."

Many people listened to the message that Peter spoke that day. "What should we do?" the people asked.

Peter told them to start making right choices and to learn more about God's Son, Jesus. Three thousand people believed what Peter said about Jesus. They met with the disciples to learn more about Jesus. This was the first church.







CONVERSATION

The First Church

ACTS 2

On a special day called Pentecost, Jesus' followers were together in one place. Suddenly, a sound like wind came from heaven and filled the whole house where they were staying. The Holy Spirit came to the believers like fiery flames and rested on them. When that happened, the believers were able to speak in different languages.

Travelers from all over the area were in the city of Jerusalem. They were faithful men from every nation under heaven. When they heard these sounds, a crowd

gathered. The people were confused because each person heard the disciples speaking in his own language. "How can this be?" they asked.

Some people laughed and said, "They are not in their right minds!"

Peter stood up and said, "Pay attention! These people are doing what the prophets predicted. You allowed evil people to nail Jesus to a cross and kill Him, but God raised Jesus from the grave. We are all witnesses of this, for we have seen Him! So let all of Israel know that God has made Jesus—the One you crucified—both Lord and Messiah!"

When the people heard this, they became upset and filled with guilt. They asked Peter and the disciples, "What should we do?"

Peter said, "Confess your sins and turn away from them. Each of you must be baptized in the name of Jesus Christ. Then you will receive the gift of the Holy Spirit."

Those who believed Peter's message believed Jesus was the Savior and were baptized. That day about 3,000 people were added to the believers and formed the first church. They listened and learned all that the disciples taught. They gathered with other believers every day to eat together and to pray.

WEEKLY BIBLE VERSE: Acts 2:46

LIFE POINT: A group of believers gather to form a church and serve God together.

THE BIBLE MEETS LIFE

The first church was formed on Pentecost when Peter preached to a crowd in Jerusalem.



LIVE IT OUT
