GIVE an Offering

Mention that Agabus traveled to Antioch to ask for help for the people in Jerusalem who needed food and money. Take the offering to your church together and allow your child to give it.



DONATE Clothes

Help your child choose some gently used clothes from her closet that are too small for her. Tell her: "The Bible tells us to do good to everyone, especially those in the church. Galatians 6:10. We can do good by giving clothes to those that need them." Take her to donate the clothes to a community ministry. Remind her the Antioch church helped the people in the Jerusalem church have what they needed.

Talk about the Bible story (reverse side) as you collect canned and boxed food. Deliver the food to a food bank or your church's food pantry with your baby. Remind your baby that the people at church helped people who were not able to get food to eat.

The people brought gifts of money and food to the church. Barnabas and Saul took the gifts to the people.






"I have news to tell you." The people at the church listened carefully. "Soon the people in Judea will not have any food or money to buy




The Antioch Church Helped

LIFE POINT: People at church show love for others and help them.







The Church in Antioch

ACTS 11:19-30

Jesus' followers who lived in Jerusalem were persecuted and treated badly. Many of them left their homes and moved to different countries and cities. Wherever they went, these believers told the people how Jesus died on the cross and rose again.

Some of Jesus' followers moved to the city of Antioch, and just as in other places, these believers began to



tell the people about all that Jesus had done. Soon, a church began in Antioch. God helped the church grow, and many people believed that Jesus is the Son of God.

The church in Jerusalem heard about the new believers in Antioch and decided to send Barnabas to teach people more about Jesus and encourage the new believers. Barnabas was a good man who was filled with the Holy Spirit and faith. When Barnabas arrived in Antioch, he was glad to see and meet the new believers. He encouraged them to remain true to Jesus.

Barnabas saw so many people believe in Jesus that he went to the city of Tarsus to get Saul and bring him to Antioch to help. For a year Barnabas and Saul met with the church and taught many people. Antioch is where believers in Jesus were called Christians for the first time.

One day some prophets came from Jerusalem to the Antioch church. One prophet named Agabus told the Antioch church that a severe famine would come to the Roman world. This included Judea, the country where Jerusalem was located. There would be no rain, and people would have a hard time finding food to eat.

The members of the church in Antioch wanted to help those who would be in need during the famine. Each person gave what he was able to give.
