

Gather NATURE ITEMS

Go for a walk. Bring along a ziplock bag to collect nature items. Guide your child to notice the things that God made. Let him put a few items inside the bag to keep. Encourage him to thank God for the things that you see. Look together at the Bible story picture (reverse side). Let your child look at the items in the bag or on a table.

BABIES

Go on a NATURE WALK

Take a walk outside with your baby. Point out everything that God made as you walk. Thank God for the flowers, grass, trees, and sky. Remind your baby that God spoke and created the world. Comment that God saw everything He had made, and it was very good.

ARRANGE FLOWERS

Let your child arrange (put) artificial flowers into a plastic vase or cup. Tell the Bible story (reverse side) to your child as he works. Pray, thanking God for making the land and plants.

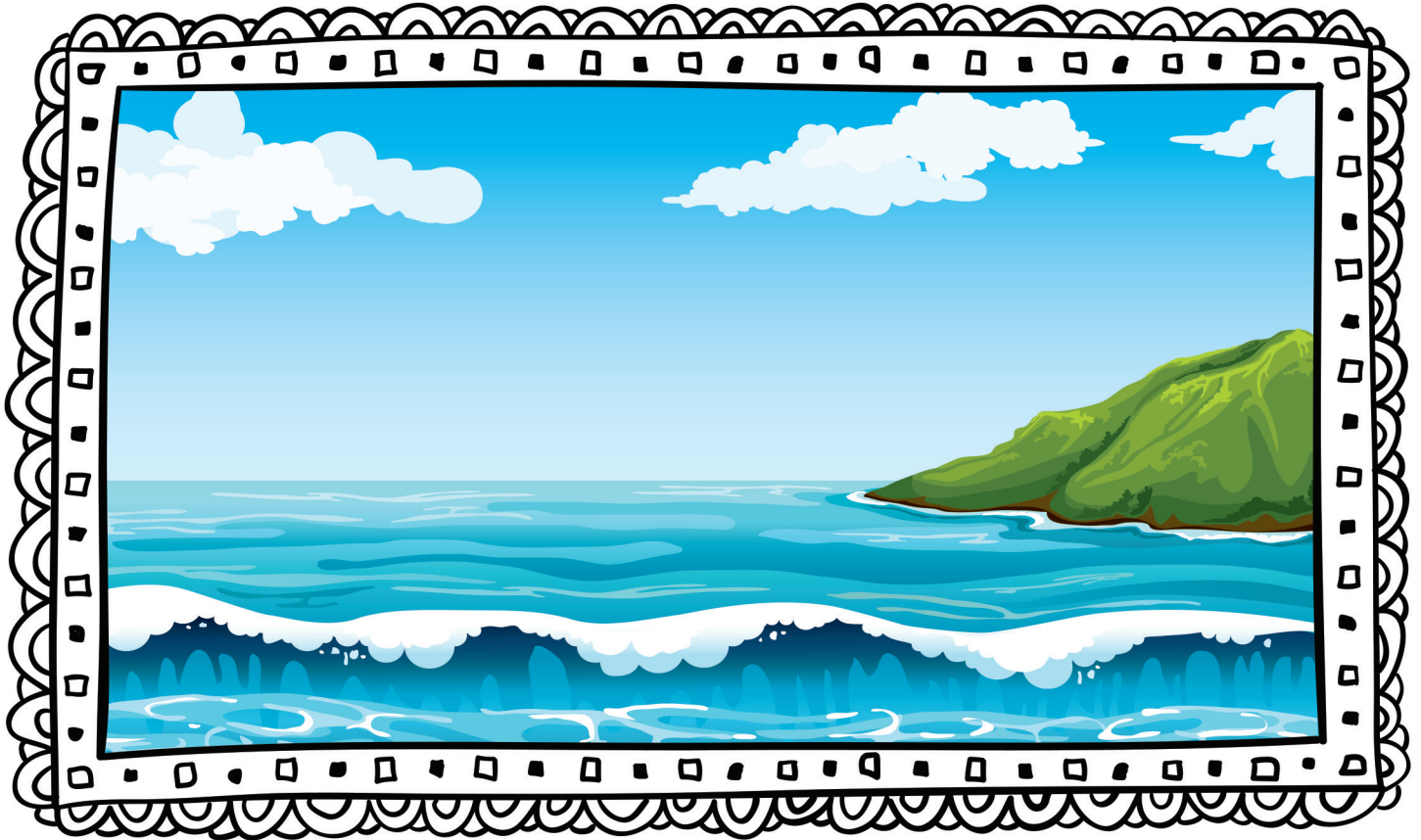

CONVERSATION

God Made the Land and Plants

BASED ON GENESIS 1:1-13

WEEKLY VERSE: In the beginning, God made the world. *Genesis 1:1*

LIFE POINT: God made the world.

In the beginning, God created the world. The world was dark and empty. Water covered the earth, and there was no light.

God said, "Let there be light!" Suddenly the light began to shine. Now there was both light and darkness. God called the light day and the darkness night. This was the first day.

On the second day, God separated the water. He created a huge space above the earth. He called the space sky.

On day three, God made dry land. He gathered water into oceans, rivers, and lakes. God made plants and trees to grow on the earth. He created the plants and trees so that each kind of plant would have its own kind of seed. Some of the plants grew vegetables. Some of the plants and trees grew fruit.

God looked at everything He had made and saw it was good.

CONVERSATION

THE BIBLE MEETS LIFE

Through this Bible story your child discovered that God created the world from nothing. God spoke and created everything in the world in six days.

LIVE IT OUT

Emphasize that God created the world from nothing! Challenge your child to use his artistic talent to make something as a way to worship God. As a family read Psalm 33:6, reminding everyone that no one is like our God, the Creator.

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The Creation

GENESIS 1:1-2:3

In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth. The earth was dark, and it did not have any shape. On the first day God said, "Let there be light," and immediately, there was light. God called the light *day* and the dark *night*. God saw that the light was good.

On the second day God said, "Let the waters separate," and the waters spread apart. God called the space in between the waters *sky*.

On the third day God said, "Let the waters under the sky gather together, and let dry land appear." As soon as God spoke these words, it happened. God called the dry land *earth* and the waters *seas*. God saw that the earth and seas were good. Then God said, "Let the earth make plants and trees that have seeds." There were plants and trees. And God saw that it was good.

On the fourth day God said, "Let there be lights in the sky to separate the day from the night." It happened as God said. God made the sun to shine during the day and the moon and stars to shine at night. And God saw that it was good.

Then God said, "Let the water be filled with creatures, and let birds fly above the earth in the sky." Living creatures filled the seas and the sky. This was the fifth day, and God saw that it was good.

On the sixth day God said, "Let the earth be filled with all kinds of animals." Livestock, creatures, and wildlife filled the earth, and God saw that it was good. Then God said, "Let Us make man in Our image and according to Our likeness to rule the fish of the sea, the birds of the sky, and every creature on the earth." So God created man in His own image. He created male and female. God saw all He had created, and it was very good.


On the seventh day God had completed His work. God blessed the seventh day and set it apart as holy. Then God rested.
