Make a PAPER SUN


Provide a round base (cardboard circle, paper plate, plastic lid, etc.), yellow pieces of paper, and a glue stick. Encourage your child to glue the yellow paper to the round base, making a sun. Suggest he glues longer strips to the outer edge for sun rays. Tell the Bible story (reverse side) as he works. Thank God for the sun.






LIFE POINT: God made day and night.

In the beginning, there was only darkness. There was no light. God


decided to create the world. He said, "Let there be light." Light began to shine. God separated the light from the darkness. God made daytime and nighttime.




God's Plan for People

GENESIS 2:4-24; PSALM 8:3-9

God formed man from the dust and breathed life into the man, so he would come alive.

God took care of the man He made. God gave the man a place to live called the garden of Eden. He filled the garden with beautiful trees that were good for food. He placed two special trees in the middle of the garden—the tree of life



and the tree of the knowledge of good and evil.

God gave the man a job to do—working in the garden and taking care of it. He gave the man a command to follow, "You may eat from any tree in the garden," God said, "except from the tree of the knowledge of good and evil. If you eat from it, you will surely die."

God brought the birds and animals to the man so that he could name them. Each living creature had a helper, but there was no helper for the man. So God put the man in a deep sleep. God took one of the man's ribs and made a woman from the rib. Then God brought her to the man to be his wife and helper.
