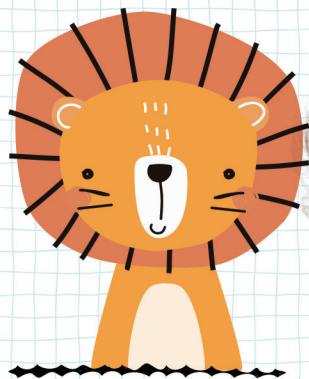


## BABIES

### God Made Animals

**BASED ON GENESIS 1:20-25**

**WEEKLY VERSE:** God saw everything He had made, and it was very good.

*Genesis 1:31*

**LIFE POINT:** God made all kinds of animals.



#### BABIES

God created the fish and the birds.

God made big and small animals that walk or crawl on the ground.

He made some animals to live on farms. He made others wild to live in the jungles or forests.

God was happy with the animals He made.

#### 1s

God spoke and made fish and all sea creatures. God also made all kinds of birds.

God spoke again, making all kinds of animals.

God made animals to live on farms, animals that live in jungles and forests, and creatures that crawl.

God was happy with the animals He made.

#### 2s

God said, "Let the waters be filled with fish and all sea creatures."

God also made the birds and all things with wings.

God made large and small animals. Some animals walk and others crawl on the ground.

He made some animals to live on farms and others that are wild and live in jungles and forests.

God made all the animals. God was happy with the animals He made.

## CONVERSATION

### God Made Animals

**BASED ON GENESIS 1:20-25**

**WEEKLY VERSE:** God saw everything He had made, and it was very good.

*Genesis 1:31*

**LIFE POINT:** God made all kinds of animals.

The Bible tells us that God made a wonderful world. In the first four days, God created darkness, light, water, and the sky. God made dry land and gathered the water into rivers, lakes, and oceans. Then God made all kinds of plants. God made the sun, moon, and stars.

God said that the world He had made was good!

On the fifth day, God said, "Let the waters be filled with living animals, and let birds fly in the sky." God created every kind of fish and animal that lives in the water. He made tiny water animals and giant whales! Then He made all kinds of birds to fly in the sky.

On the sixth day, God made animals to live on the land. God made all the wild animals, farm animals, and every kind of animal.

In two days, God made all the many different kinds of animals. God looked at all the animals He made and the beautiful world He made. It was all very good.

## CONVERSATION

### Adam's and Eve's Choices

#### GENESIS 3

One day a serpent approached Eve and asked, "Did God really say, 'You can't eat from any tree in the garden?'"

Eve corrected the serpent, "We may eat fruit from any tree except the one in the middle of the garden. God said, 'You must not touch or eat that fruit, or you will die.'"

The serpent told Eve, "You won't die! In fact, God knows that when you eat it, you will be like Him, knowing good and evil."

Eve looked at the wonderful fruit on the tree. She remembered that the serpent said the fruit would make her wise. Eve took some of the fruit and ate it. She gave some to Adam, and he ate it, too.

Immediately, Adam and Eve realized what they had done. They tried to cover themselves and hide from God.

That evening God called out to Adam. "Where are you? Did you eat from the tree I commanded you not to?"

Adam said, "The woman You gave me—she gave me some fruit from the tree, and I ate it."

Eve said, "The serpent tricked me, and I ate it."

God told the serpent, "Because you have done this, you are cursed more than any other animal. You will move on your belly and eat dust." Then God told Eve, "You will have pain when you have a baby." God told Adam, "You must work hard to grow your food now, and one day you will die."

God made Adam and Eve leave the garden.

**WEEKLY BIBLE VERSE:** Psalm 53:3

**LIFE POINT:** People choose to sin and become separated from God.



#### THE BIBLE MEETS LIFE

From this Bible story your child heard that Adam and Eve chose to sin and disobey God. Sin entered the world, and as a result, all people choose to sin and become separated from God. The good news is God still loves us and sent Jesus to save us from sin.

#### LIVE IT OUT

Help your child memorize Psalm 53:3. Guide her to write some choices that reflect turning away from or rejecting God and His commands. Pray about the things she wrote, asking God to help your family turn from sin and to help your family love and obey Him more intentionally each day.

#### LEVEL OF BIBLICAL LEARNING

God made people in His image to have a personal relationship with Him.
