Sort CLOTHING

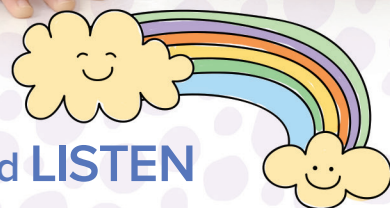
Look into your child's closet or at his clothes with him. Say that Samuel grew and his robes would get too small to wear. Tell that Samuel's mother made him a new robe each year for him to wear in the tabernacle (tent church). Together, choose clothing for your child to wear. Look for any clothing your child has outgrown and donate to a friend or a charity. Say a simple prayer, thanking God for providing everything we need, including clothing.



PITCH a TENT

Spread a blanket or sheet across furniture to make a "tent." Take a Bible and a few other books and sit inside the tent with your child. Show the Bible story picture (reverse side). Tell that Samuel's church was called a tabernacle and was like a big tent. Note that Samuel learned about God in the tabernacle. Open the Bible to Isaiah 45:5 and read aloud: "I am God; there is no God but Me." Invite your child to choose other books to read.

BABIES



LOOK and LISTEN

Sit with your baby outside where she can see trees, flowers, and hear different sounds. Say that God made the trees and flowers. Guide your baby to listen to a bird sing or a car go by. Say: "God made Samuel. God made you. Samuel heard God call to him. God is real. I'm so glad we can know about Him."

Samuel in the Tabernacle

**BASED ON 1 SAMUEL 1:24-28;
2:18-26; 3**

WEEKLY VERSE: I am God; there is no God but Me. *Isaiah 45:5*

LIFE POINT: God is real, and people can know about Him.



Samuel's mother, Hannah, prayed for Samuel before he was born. In her prayer she wanted Samuel to work for God. Samuel was a very young boy when his mother took him to the tent church in Shiloh.

She told Eli, the church helper, that she wanted Samuel to be his helper at church. She wanted Eli to teach Samuel about serving God at church and doing the things God wanted him to do.

Samuel's mother went to see him every year and took him a new robe when she would visit. Samuel continued to grow, and God was pleased with him. The people of Israel also liked Samuel.

One night when Samuel was lying down to sleep, God called his name, "Samuel!" Samuel thought that Eli was calling him. God called to Samuel three times. The fourth time God called him, Eli helped Samuel to know that God was calling him. Eli helped Samuel listen to God.

Samuel told the people what God wanted them to know. People listened to what Samuel said. They knew that Samuel loved God and listened to God's words.

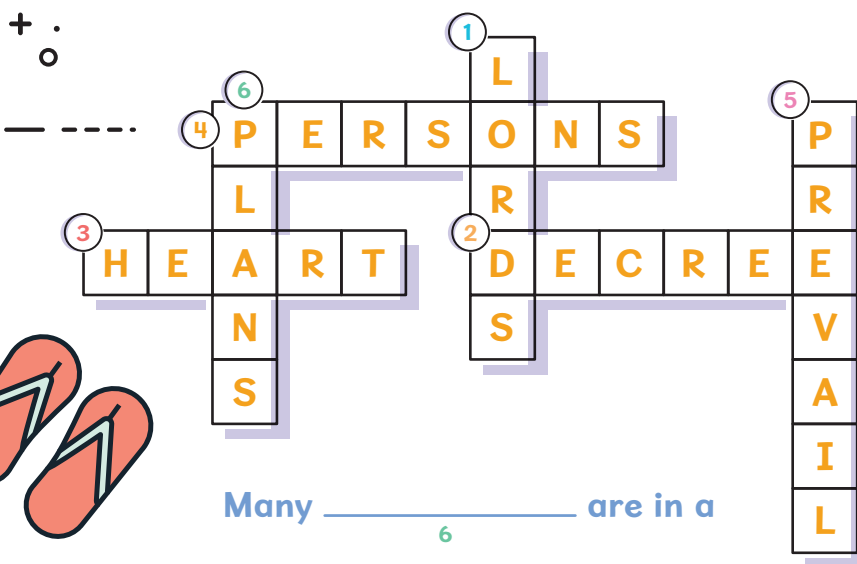

CONVERSATION

God Called Samuel

1 SAMUEL 1:24-28; 2:18-26; 3

A woman named Hannah prayed to have a child, and God answered her prayer! Hannah had a son, and she named him Samuel. Hannah kept the promise she made to God before Samuel was born. When Samuel was old enough, she took him to the tabernacle and dedicated him to the Lord. She told the priest, Eli, "For as long as he lives, he belongs to the Lord."



Samuel grew and helped Eli at the tabernacle. During that time, messages from God were rare, but one night Samuel heard a voice calling his name. Samuel ran to Eli. "Here I am! Did you call me?" Samuel said.

Eli said, "I didn't call. Go back and lie down." Two more times Samuel heard the voice, and two more times he ran to Eli. Finally, Eli understood. He told Samuel, "The next time you hear the voice, say 'Speak, Lord! Your servant is listening.'"

Samuel did exactly what Eli said. God told Samuel that Eli's sons had done bad things. God was planning to punish Eli and all of Eli's family because of the evil things Eli's sons had done.

Samuel went back to bed and slept until morning. He did not want to tell Eli about God's message. When Eli wanted to hear what God had said, Samuel was brave and told Eli the truth.

God continued to give His messages for the people to Samuel. God was with Samuel, and Samuel served God. All the people knew that Samuel was God's prophet.

WEEKLY BIBLE VERSE: Proverbs 19:21

LIFE POINT: God chooses people to do His work.

THE BIBLE MEETS LIFE

Your child learned that God chooses people to do His work. Samuel's mother dedicated him to God when he was very young. Later, God called Samuel to be His prophet.

LIVE IT OUT

Review the Bible story about God's call to Samuel. Encourage your child to write a note to or have a conversation with a church staff member, asking about that person's call to ministry. Pray, thanking God for people whom God calls to work in full-time ministry.
