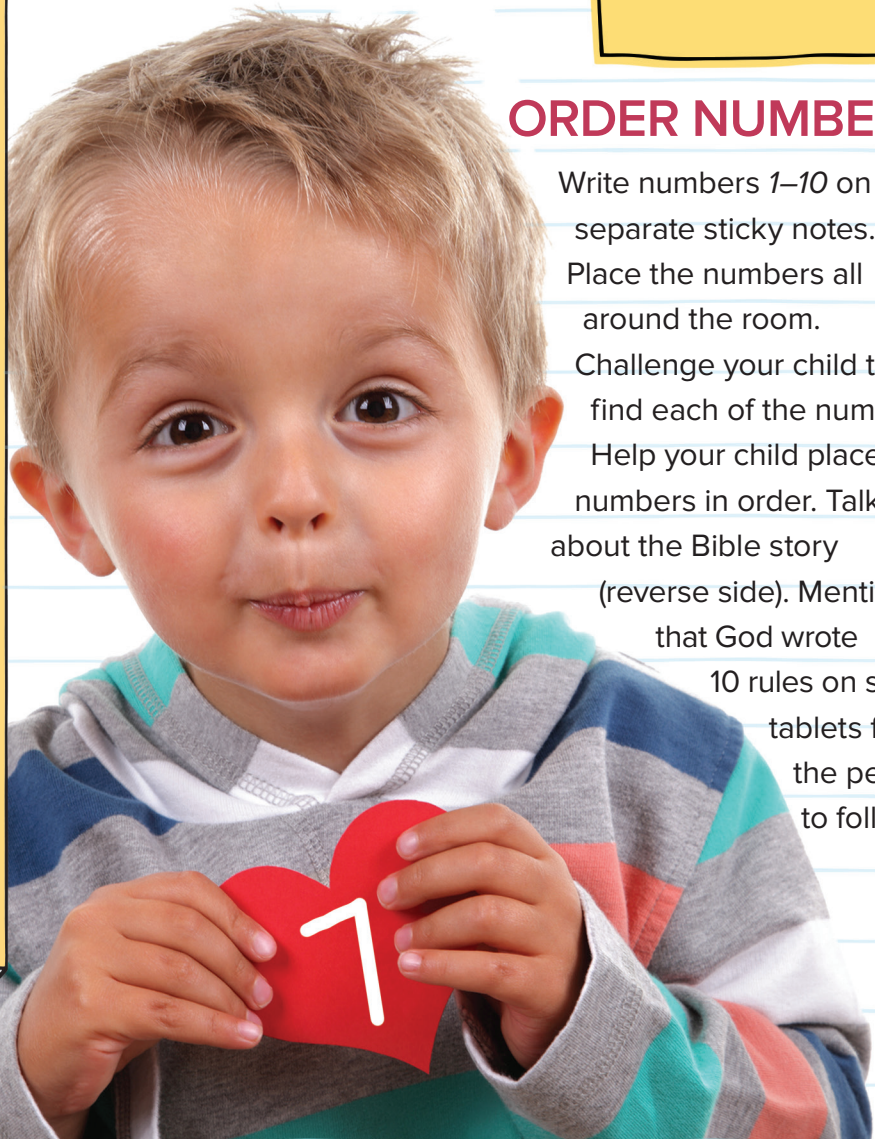

**WRITE on a
Tablet**

Tear two pieces of aluminum foil, one for your child and one for yourself. Wrap the foil pieces around or tape to cardboard pieces. Write on your foil with a crayon, encouraging your child to write on his foil. Talk about the Bible story. Mention that God's words were written on tablets (stones). The tablets were given to Moses to tell the people how to live and what to do.

Write numbers 1–10 on separate sticky notes. Place the numbers all around the room. Challenge your child to find each of the numbers. Help your child place the numbers in order. Talk about the Bible story (reverse side). Mention that God wrote 10 rules on stone tablets for the people to follow.

READ to Your Baby

Look at the Bible with your infant. Explain: “The Bible is a special book. Words in the Bible are from God.” Read aloud this week’s Bible story (reverse side). Open the Bible to Exodus 19:8 and read aloud the verse. Explain: “God wrote words on the stone tablets that told the people what to do and not do. The people said, ‘We will do what God says.’ The Bible helps us learn what God wants us to do.”

CONVERSATION

God Gave Rules to Moses

BASED ON EXODUS 19–20; 31:18

WEEKLY VERSE: We will do what God says. *Exodus 19:8*

LIFE POINT: The words in the Bible are from God.

After Moses and the people of Israel left Egypt, they camped in the desert. Moses was leading the people to a special land God had told them to find.

One day God told Moses to leave the camp and walk up a mountain. God wanted to talk to Moses.

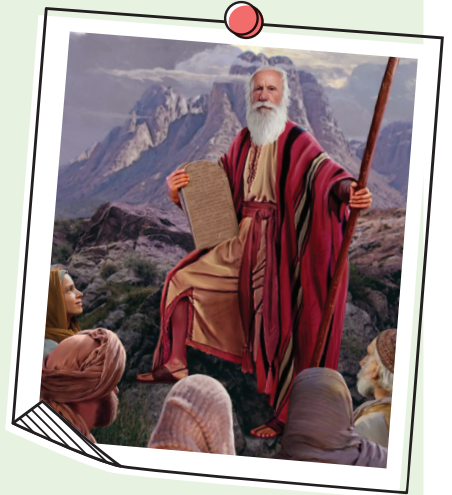
God said, “Moses, tell the people to obey Me. I want them to know the right thing to do.”

Then God talked to Moses again. God gave Moses ten important rules called the Ten Commandments. These rules would help the people know how to treat one another and love God. God said that if the people would do what He said, He would remember them always, and they would be His special people forever.

Moses told the people what God said, and the people listened. These are some of God’s rules He wanted the people to follow: Love God. Worship God only. Love your mother and father. Keep your marriage promises. Do not steal. Always tell the truth.

The people said, “We will do everything God said.”

God wrote the Ten Commandments on stone tablets with His finger. He gave them to Moses so the people would know how to obey God.

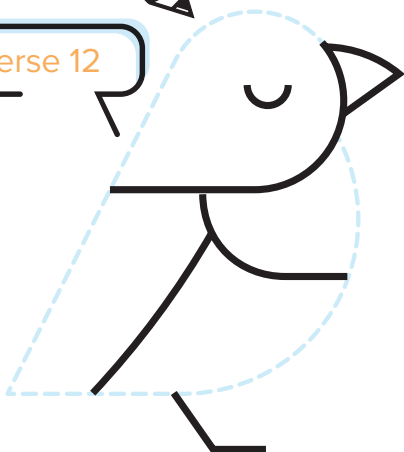

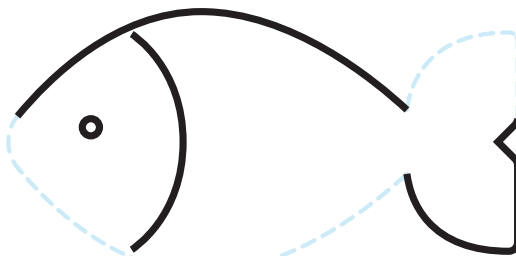
FINISH the Picture

From sea to sky, the Bible tells us that God is in charge of all creation! Look up Psalm 104 to complete the pictures of some of what God created.

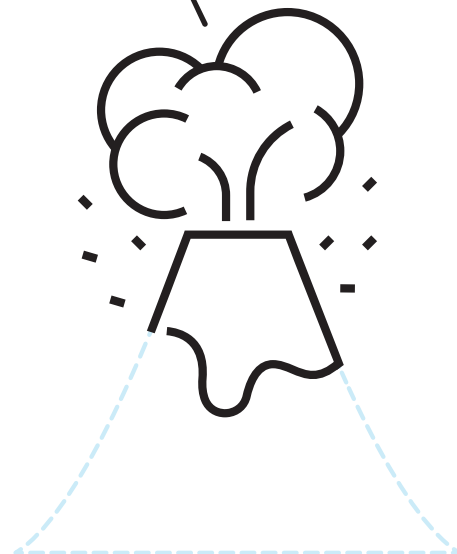

CONVERSATION

A Psalm About Creation

PSALM 104

The very first words of the Bible in Genesis 1:1 are: “In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth.” But the story doesn’t stop there! The Bible is full of reminders that God is in charge of all creation.

One of those reminders is a psalm—a song of praise. The psalmist praised God for His power over all creation and wrote about God’s majesty and power. He spread out the sky. He controls the wind and fire. Mountains rose and valleys sank in exactly the places God planned for them to be.

The psalm praised God for providing for His creation. God caused grass to grow so animals could eat. God provided crops and food for people to eat. God gave animals places to live and gives them food at exactly the right time. He gave people work to do.

The psalmist praised God just because God deserves praise! The psalmist knew God’s works were too many to be numbered—they are countless! God made everything with wisdom. The earth is full of things God created!

The psalmist said he would sing to God all of his life and wanted all of his thoughts to be pleasing to God.

WEEKLY BIBLE VERSE: Psalm 104:24

LIFE POINT: The Bible teaches that God is in charge of all creation.



THE BIBLE MEETS LIFE
