HIDE a Bible

Hide a Bible in a place your child can easily find it. Celebrate when the Bible is found. Explain that the Bible contains God's words. Say that King Josiah's helpers found a scroll of God's words when they cleaned the temple (church). Say: "We are to obey God and follow His commands. Deuteronomy 27:10."

FIND a Scroll

Help your child put misplaced toys in their correct places. Talk about the Bible story (reverse side). Comment that King Josiah told workers to clean and repair the temple (church). State that when they cleaned, they found something important.

Explain that when we clean, we sometimes find things that have been lost. As you collect toys, remind your child that God wants us to keep our home and church clean. Say the Weekly Verse: "Obey God and follow His commands. Deuteronomy 27:10."

BABIES

See My HANDS

Hold your baby's hands in yours. Name things she can do with her hands. Invite her to use her hands to hold a toy or wipe a toy with a soft cloth. Tell the Bible story (reverse side). Say: "The workers found the scroll with God's words." Guide her to pat the Bible with her hands. Remark: "God's words are in the Bible. The Bible helps us know what to do."

WEEKLY VERSE: Obey God and follow His commands. *Deuteronomy 27:10*

LIFE POINT: The Bible teaches people what to do.

CONVERSATION

Josiah Read the Scroll

BASED ON 2 KINGS 22:1-23:3

WEEKLY VERSE: Obey God and follow His commands. *Deuteronomy 27:10*

LIFE POINT: The Bible teaches people what to do.



Josiah was eight years old when he became king. Even though he was only a boy, he loved God and wanted to obey Him. Josiah grew to be a man and still wanted to obey God.

The temple (church) needed to be cleaned and repaired. King Josiah told one of his helpers, "Tell Hilkiah (hil KIGH uh) to give money to carpenters, builders, and stone masons to repair the temple."

The workers found a Bible scroll. Hilkiah gave the scroll to one of the king's helpers. The helper read words from the Bible scroll. When King Josiah heard the words, he was very sad. He tore his clothes. "The words of this Bible scroll tell us what God wants us to do," Josiah said. "We have not been doing these things."

King Josiah called the people to the temple. The people listened to the words from the Bible scroll. King Josiah promised he would do the things God wanted him to do. The people promised God they would do all the things the Bible scroll said.

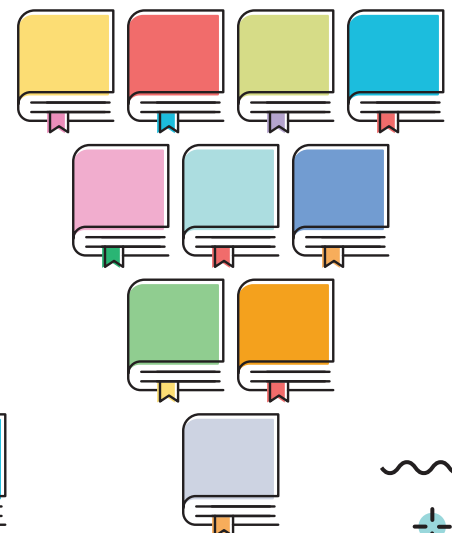
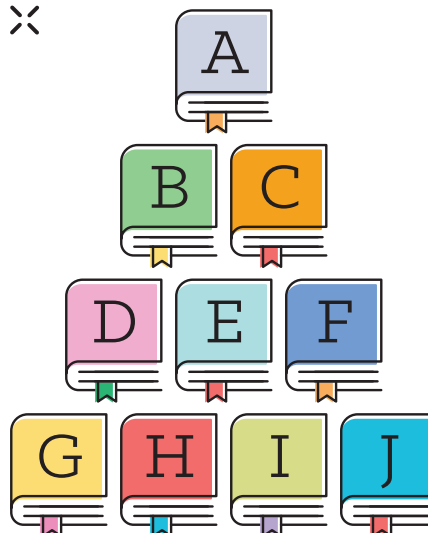

CONVERSATION

Jesus Read the Scriptures

LUKE 4:16-22

Jesus grew up in the town of Nazareth, and the people there remembered Him as Joseph and Mary's son. After Jesus was grown, He returned to Nazareth. He went to the synagogue on the Sabbath Day, just as He always did in whatever town or city He happened to be visiting.



Someone gave Jesus a scroll which Isaiah, a prophet of God, wrote hundreds of years before Jesus was born. Jesus stood up and began to read aloud from the scroll.

He read the words that God had told Isaiah many years before: "The Spirit of the Lord is on Me. He has chosen Me to preach good news to the poor. He has sent Me to tell the captives that they are free, to give sight to the blind, to free people who have been treated badly, and to announce that the Lord's favor is on us."

After Jesus read these words, He rolled up the scroll and sat down. Everyone in the synagogue stared at Jesus.

Jesus told the crowd, "Today as you listened to Me reading these words, they have come true." Jesus was telling the people that He was the Savior whom God had promised to send.

The people asked, "Isn't this Joseph's son?" They were amazed at what Jesus said.

WEEKLY BIBLE VERSE: Isaiah 61:1

LIFE POINT: The Bible teaches that Jesus is the Savior.

THE BIBLE MEETS LIFE

This Bible story taught your child that Jesus is the Savior. In a synagogue in Nazareth, Jesus read Scriptures from the prophet Isaiah. The Scriptures were about Jesus and why God sent Him.
