## **FXAMINE** Jesus' Words

Open your Bible to Luke 4:21 and read aloud the verse to your child. Remark: "The Scriptures in the Bible tell about Jesus." If your Bible shows Jesus' words in red, point out the red letters. Explain that the Bible tells us what Jesus said. Tell the Bible story (reverse side).



## Make a **SCROLL**

Tell the Bible story (reverse side). Write on a sheet of paper Jesus said, "The Scriptures tell about Me." Luke 4:21. Give your child the paper and help her roll the paper up on both ends like a scroll. Let her open the scroll. Read aloud the verse several times. Invite her to "read" aloud the scroll. Remind her that the Bible tells us about Jesus.

## **Enjoy OUTSIDE TIME**

Spread a blanket on the ground outside. Sit with your baby on the blanket. Blow bubbles in the air. Say: "We read in the Bible that Jesus often spent time outside." Show pictures in a Bible of Jesus walking, teaching, and talking to people outside. Mention that Jesus also walked to a synagogue (church). Say: "Jesus read aloud the Scriptures. The Scriptures are in our Bible. The Bible tells about Jesus. Thank You, God, for the Bible."



## Jesus Read the Scroll

#### **BASED ON LUKE 4:16-22**

**WEEKLY VERSE:** Jesus said, "The Scripture tells about Me." *Luke 4:21* 

**LIFE POINT:** The Bible tells about Jesus.

Jesus went to many places teaching people about God. One day Jesus went to Nazareth.

Nazareth was the town where Jesus lived with His family when He was a boy.


Jesus went to the synagogue (church) in Nazareth. He stood where everyone could see Him. A church helper handed Jesus the scroll of Scriptures (Bible scroll).

Jesus carefully unrolled the scroll. He began to read from Isaiah: "God sent Me to tell people the good news about Him. God sent Me to help people." Jesus rolled up the scroll. He gave it back to the church helper and sat down.

Everyone was watching Jesus. Jesus looked at the people and said, "The words I read in the Scriptures tell about Me."

The people knew Jesus had grown up in Mary and Joseph's family, but they did not know that Jesus was God's Son. The people were surprised at what Jesus said.

## Hearing and Doing the Word

#### **JAMES 1:19-26**

Jesus had a half brother named James. James became the leader of the church in Jerusalem. James wrote a letter to explain how followers of Jesus should

James wrote that everyone should be quick to listen, slow to speak, and slow to become angry. Being angry does not show that a person desires to obey

James said that people should get rid of all the evil things in their lives and listen humbly to God's Word, which is able to save anyone.

"Don't just listen to God's Word," James continued. "Do what it says! If someone hears God's Word and doesn't obey it, he is like a person who looks at himself in a mirror, then walks away and forgets what he is like! But if you look at God's Word carefully and do the good things it says, you will be blessed in what you do."

James added one more warning: "If anyone thinks he is a religious person but cannot control his words, he is lying to himself, and his worship is worthless."
