## PICK Up Toys

Ask your child to pick up the toys. Make it a fun time as you demonstrate picking up toys together. Show the Bible story picture (reverse side). Tell how Martha was busy making sure her visit with Jesus was special. Say that Mary sat by Jesus and listened to Him tell about God's love.

## Make a MEAL

Allow your child to help make a meal with you. State that Martha made a meal for Jesus. Tell the Bible story (reverse side). Pray, thanking God for the good food to eat. Enjoy eating the food you make with your family.

## BABIES

## LISTEN and Do

Sit facing your baby. Clap your hands and say: "Mommy says 'Clap your hands.'" Say and do other actions for her to do such as wave and reach up high. Encourage your baby to

do what you do. Touch your baby's ear and say: "We listen with our ears." Tell this week's Bible story (reverse side). Say: "Mary chose to listen to Jesus teach. God helps us know which choices are right."



## CONVERSATION

Jesus Visited Mary and Martha

#### **LUKE 10:38-42**

One day Jesus was traveling with His disciples. They stopped at a village where a woman named Martha welcomed Jesus into her home. Martha's sister, Mary, was at the house, too.

After Jesus came in, He began to teach the people gathered in Martha's home. Mary sat at Jesus' feet with the other people and listened to everything

He said, but Martha was distracted. There was so much work to do!

Martha hurried to get things ready to serve Jesus and the others,
but Mary made a different choice. She continued to sit near Jesus
and listen to all He said.

Martha was upset! She came to Jesus and said, "Lord, don't You care that my sister has left all the work to me? Tell Mary to help me!"

Jesus answered Martha in a surprising way. He said, "Martha, Martha, you are worried and upset about so many things, but really only one thing is the most important. Mary has made the right choice. Her choice will not be taken away from her."
