### LOOK at a Bible

Help your baby open the Bible and turn pages. Explain that the Bible is special book. Say: "Stories in the Bible help us learn about God." Turn to Exodus 3. Show the Bible story picture (reverse side) and tell the Bible story. Comment: "God told Moses He would help him. God helps us, too. God is good to us." Pray and thank God for ways He helps and takes care of your family.

#### **HELP Each Other**

Talk to your child about being a helper. Give him special jobs to do around the house. Encourage your child as he helps. Tell that God gave Moses a special job to do. Talk about the Bible story (reverse side). Thank your child for being a helper.



WEEKLY VERSE: God is good to us.



from everyone, in the wilderness, by a mountain.




God told Moses about His plans to save the Israelite people. Pharaoh, the king of Egypt, kept them as slaves. He was mean to the people and made them work very hard. God heard the people ask for help.

God said, "Moses, I am sending you to talk to Pharaoh so that you can lead the people out of Egypt." Moses tried to make excuses. He did not think he could lead the people. God said, "Tell the people that I am the God of their family—the God of Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob. I will be with them."



## Moses and the Burning Bush

#### EXODUS 3:1-4:17

Moses had been born in Egypt, but now he lived far away and took care of sheep. One day Moses noticed a bush that was burning, but the bush did not burn up!

Suddenly, God called from the bush, "Moses! Don't come any closer. Take off your sandals. You are standing on holy ground." Moses was afraid to look at God, so he hid his face. Then God said, "I have seen how My people are suffering in Egypt. I have heard them cry out, and I have come to rescue them.



Moses, I want you to lead My people out of Egypt!"

Moses did not understand why God would choose him, but God assured Moses that He would be with him. Moses asked, "What will I say when the people want to know Who sent me? What should I tell them?"

God said, "I AM WHO I AM. Say, 'I AM' has sent me!" Moses responded, "What if they won't believe me?"

God gave Moses three miraculous signs to convince the people that God sent him. First, God said, "Throw your staff on the ground." Moses' staff turned into a snake! When God told Moses to pick up the snake by the tail, it became a staff again. Next, God said, "Put your hand inside your cloak." When Moses took out his hand, it was covered with a skin disease. God told Moses to take his hand from his cloak a second time, and it was healed! Finally, God told Moses, "If the people still do not believe, take water from the Nile River and pour it on the ground. It will turn into blood." God assured Moses that these signs would show the people that God had sent him.

Still, Moses made excuses. He exclaimed, "Please, Lord! I do not speak well."

God replied, "I will help you speak."

Moses begged, "Please send someone else!" God became angry with Moses, but He sent Moses' brother, Aaron, to help him speak to the people. God said that He would teach Moses and Aaron what to do.
