VERSE

God made everything

- Nehemiah 9.6



Purchase fruit your child enjoys to eat. Let your child help wash the fruit. Cut the fruit into small bitesize pieces for you both to enjoy. Say: "God made the earth and everything on it. Nehemiah 9:6." Mention that God made trees and bushes that make fruit. Thank God for the fruit you eat.

PLAY Day and Night

Talk with your child about how God made the sun to shine during the day and the moon and stars to shine at night. Gather daytime items (sunglasses, play clothes, sun hat). Lead your child to dress up for daytime. Gather nighttime items (pajamas, slippers, pillow, blanket). Dress and play out nighttime activities. Tell the Bible story (reverse side). State that God made day and night.



ENJOY Time Outside

Sit outside with your baby. Guide him to look at the sky. Say: "God made the sky." Hold his hand and help him touch the grass. Say: "God made the grass." Point out other things God made. Comment: "The Bible tells us: 'God made the earth and everything on it." Tell the Bible story (reverse side). Softly sing to the tune of "God Is So Good": "I thank You, God. / I thank You, God. / I thank You, God. / You're so good to me."

CONVERSATION

God Made the World

BASED ON GENESIS 1:1-19

WEEKLY VERSE: God made the earth and everything on it. Nehemiah 9:6

LIFE POINT: God made the world.

In the beginning, God created the world. The world was dark and empty. Water covered the earth, and there was no light.

God said, "Let there be light!" Suddenly the light began to shine. Now there was both light and darkness. God called the light day and the darkness night. This was the first day.

On the second day, God separated the water. He created a huge space above the earth. He called the huge space sky.

On the third day, God made dry land. He gathered water into oceans, rivers, and lakes. God made plants and trees to grow on the earth. He created the plants and trees so that each kind of plant would have its own kind of seed. Some of the plants grew vegetables. Some of the plants and trees grew fruit.




The moon is not in a corner, but the grapes are.

The flower is in the same column as the mouse, which is the same row as the fish.




















CONVERSATION

Creation from Nothing

GENESIS 1:1-2:3

In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth. The earth was dark and did not have any shape. On the first day God said, "Let there be light." Immediately, there was light. God called the light day and the dark night. God saw that the light was good.

On the second day God said, "Let the waters separate," and the waters spread apart. God called the space between the waters sky.

On the third day God said, "Let the waters under the sky gather together, and let dry land appear." As soon as God spoke these words, it happened. God called the dry land earth and the waters seas. God saw that the earth and seas were good. Then God said, "Let the earth make plants and trees that have seed." There were plants and trees. And God saw that it was good.

On the fourth day God said, "Let there be lights in the sky to separate the day from the night." It happened as God said. God made the sun to shine during the day and the moon and stars to shine at night. And God saw that it was good.

Then God said, "Let the water be filled with creatures, and let birds fly above the earth in the sky." Living creatures filled the seas and the sky. This was the fifth day, and God saw that it was good.

On the sixth day God said, "Let the earth be filled with all kinds of animals." Livestock, creatures, and wildlife filled the earth, and God saw that it was good. Then God said, "Let Us make man in Our image and according to Our likeness to rule the fish of the sea, the birds of the sky, and every creature on the earth." So God created man in His own image. He created a man and a woman. God saw all He had created, and He thought it was very good.

On the seventh day God had completed His work. God blessed the seventh day and said that it was holy. Then God rested.
