
LOOK at Animal Pictures




VERSE

Take your child to the zoo or a pet store. Show your child the different kinds of animals God made. Explain that birds fly in the sky and fish swim in the water. Tell how other animals live on the land. Review the Bible story (reverse side). Pray, thanking God for all the animals He has made.

BABIES

WATCH Birds

Find a pinecone, spread it with a thin layer of peanut butter, and roll it in birdseed. Tie string to the end of the pinecone. Hang the pinecone outside near a window where you and your baby can see it. Watch for birds. Tell the Bible story (reverse side). Comment: "God cares for the birds and animals He made. We can help care for them, too. We can give them food to eat like our pinecone." Thank God for all the birds and animals He made.

WEEKLY VERSE: The earth is full of the living things God made. *Psalm 104:24*

LIFE POINT: God made all of the animals.



BABIES

God made fish and other animals to live in water.

God made birds and other things with wings to fly in the sky.

God made the wild animals and the livestock (cows, horses, and sheep).

God made animals to crawl on the ground.

God said all that He made was good.



God said, "Let there be animals."

God made big animals and little animals. He made the birds and the fish.

God made some animals to walk on the ground, some to swim in the water, and others to fly.

God liked what He saw.



God said, "Let there be animals." God made little animals and big animals.

God made the birds that fly. He filled the waters with all kinds of fish and other animals.

God made farm animals (livestock), such as cows, goats, chickens, and horses.

God made wild animals (wildlife), such as lions, elephants, bears, and deer.

God made animals that crawl on the ground, such as snakes and lizards.

God looked at all He had made and said it was good.




MATCH the SHADOWS

WEEKLY VERSE: The earth is full of the living things God made. *Psalm 104:24*

LIFE POINT: God made all of the animals

The Bible tells us that God made a wonderful world. In the first four days,

God created darkness, light, water, and the sky. God made dry land and gathered the water into rivers, lakes, and oceans.
Then God made all kinds of plants. God made the sun, moon, and stars.

God said that the world He had made was good!

On the fifth day, God said, "Let the waters be filled with living animals, and let birds fly in the sky." God created every kind of fish and animal that lives in the water. He made tiny water animals and giant whales! Then He made all kinds of birds to fly in the sky.

On the sixth day, God made animals to live on the land. God made all the wild animals, farm animals, and every other kind of animal.

In two days, God made all the different kinds of animals. God looked at all the animals He made and the beautiful world He made. It was all very good.













When God created the world, He also created order and provision. God gave water for the plants, plants for the animals, and people to care for all His creation. God's creation = all good!

The Garden of Eden

GENESIS 2:4-24

When God created the heavens and the earth, at first, there were no shrubs or plants growing. God had not yet made it rain, and there was no one to care for the land. So God made a mist of water come out of the ground to water the entire surface of the land. After that, God formed man out of

dust from the ground. He breathed the

breath of life into him, and the man became a living being.

Then God made a garden in a place called Eden. He put the man there and gave him the garden to work and to watch over. God made beautiful trees grow that were good for food. In the middle of the garden, He also placed the tree of life and the tree of the knowledge of good and evil.

The man was allowed to eat from any tree in the garden, but God commanded him not to eat from the tree of the knowledge of good and evil. He warned the man that if he ate from that tree, he would certainly die.

Then God looked at the man and said, "It is not good for you to be alone"

LIFE POINT: God created people. He placed them over His creation.


