**COMPARE
Shoes**

Place the shoes of your family together in a row. Talk about the size of each shoe. Hold each shoe and ask your child who the shoe belongs to. Explain that the Bible says God made people. Tell the Bible story (reverse side). Pray, thanking God for the people in your family.

BABIES

TALK to God

Gently bounce your baby on your lap and sing the tune of "London Bridge": "God made me and God made you. / God made you. God made you. / God made me and God made you. / Thank You, God." Say: "God made people." Tell the Bible story (reverse side). Say: "We talk to God when we pray." Thank God for your baby, your family, friends, and your church family.

**LOOK at People
Pictures**

Look at photo albums or pictures of people on your phone with your child. Mention that God made the first man and woman named Adam and Eve. Tell the Bible story (reverse side). Name the people in the pictures and say that God made them, too!

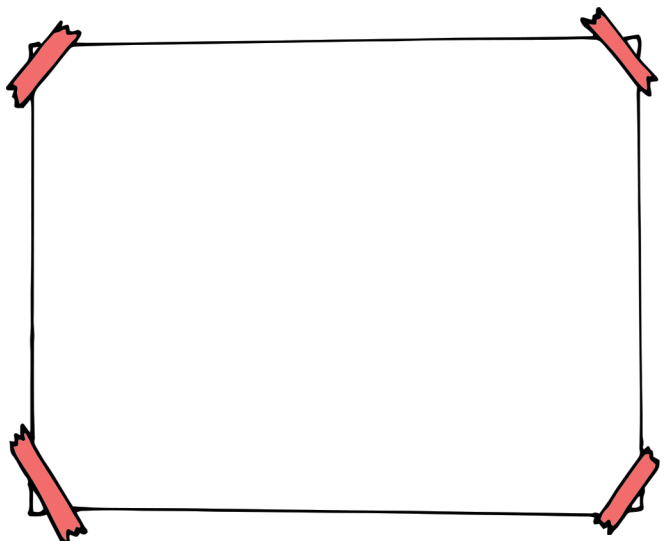

God Made People

BASED ON GENESIS 1:26–2:24

WEEKLY VERSE: God placed the man in the garden to take care of it.
Genesis 2:15

LIFE POINT: God made people.

God made a wonderful world. He made day and night, land and water, and plants and trees. God made the sun, moon, and stars. He made animals that live in water, birds, and land animals.

After God made all the land animals on the sixth day, He said, “I will make man. He will be in charge of all the animals. He will take care of the plants I have made.”

The man, named Adam, lived in the garden of Eden. God told him to work in the garden and take care of it.

God brought the animals to Adam and said, “Give each animal a name.” Adam did what God told him to do.

Then God decided the man should not be alone. He made a woman to be Adam’s helper. Now Adam would not be alone. God made Adam and Eve different from the other things He made. He made them able to choose to love and obey Him.

Evening came, and the sixth day was done. On the seventh day, God rested. He created everything in six days!

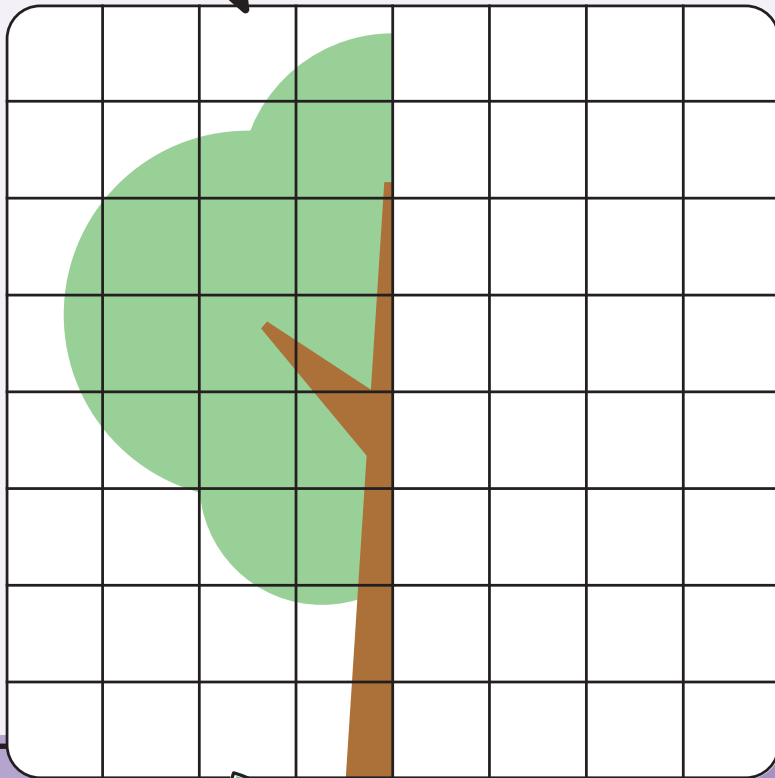

Sin and Consequences

GENESIS 3

One day a serpent approached Eve and asked, “Did God really say, ‘You can’t eat from any tree in the garden?’”

Eve corrected the serpent: “We may eat fruit from any tree except the one in the middle of the garden. God said, ‘You must not touch or eat that fruit, or you will die.’”

The serpent told Eve, “You won’t die! In fact, God knows that when you eat it, you will be like Him, knowing good and evil.”

Eve looked at the wonderful fruit on the tree. She remembered that the serpent said the fruit would make her wise. Eve took some of the fruit and ate it. She gave some to Adam, and he ate it, too.

Immediately, Adam and Eve realized what they had done. They tried to cover themselves and hide from God.

That evening, God called out to Adam, “Where are you? Did you eat from the tree I commanded you not to?”

Adam said, “The woman You gave me—she gave me some fruit from the tree, and I ate it.”

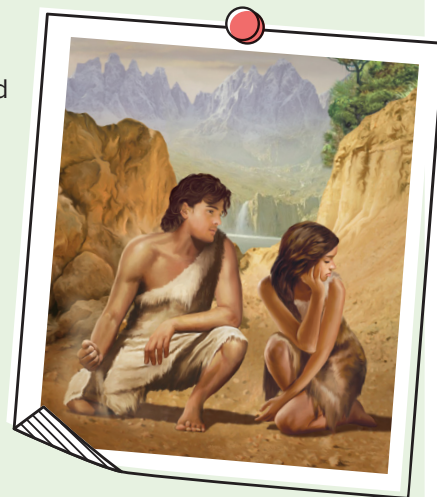
Eve said, “The serpent tricked me, and I ate it.”

God told the serpent, “Because you have done this, you are cursed more than any other animal. You will move on your belly and eat dust.” Then God told Eve, “You will have pain when you have a baby.” God told Adam, “You must work hard to grow your food now, and one day you will die.”

God made Adam and Eve leave the garden.

WEEKLY BIBLE VERSE: Romans 5:12

LIFE POINT: God created people to have a relationship with Him.



THE BIBLE MEETS LIFE

From this Bible story your child discovered that God created people to have a relationship with Him. The man and woman walked with God in the garden, but the man and woman ruined the relationship by sinning. Sin separates people from God, but God had a plan to restore the relationship.

LIVE IT OUT

Help your child memorize Romans 5:12. Discuss the consequences of sin (disobeying God) coming into the world. Remind her that God had a plan from the beginning to restore His relationship with people—He planned to send Jesus to die and raise Him to life to save people from sin.

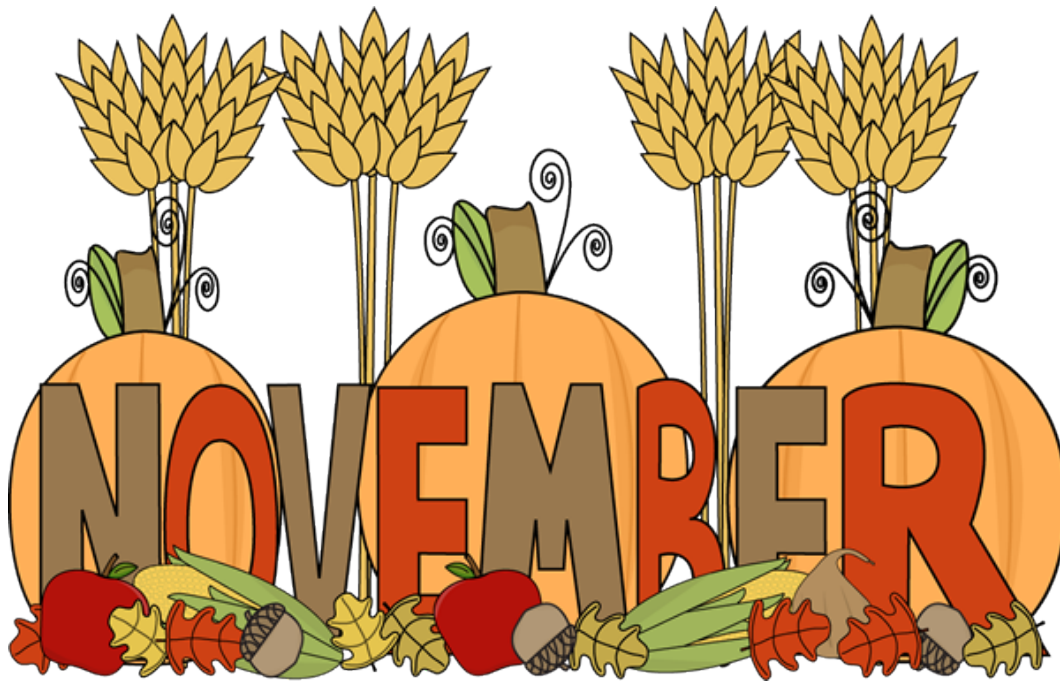
