

WASH Stones

Take your child outside to find a stone. Place the stone in a bowl of water and encourage your child to wash the stone. Recall that the women came to the place where Jesus had been buried (see story on reverse side). Tell that the stone was rolled away and the tomb was empty. Say an angel told the women that Jesus was alive. Mention that the women were happy. Dry the stone and use a marker to draw a happy face on the stone. Encourage your child to put the stone in a special place to remember that Jesus is alive.

MAKE Faces

Encourage your child to look in a mirror. Say: "Make a happy face!" Ask your child to continue making faces in the mirror, showing different emotions like excited, sad, and angry. Read the Bible story (reverse side) together. Talk about how the women were happy to find out Jesus is alive. Pray, thanking God that Jesus is alive.

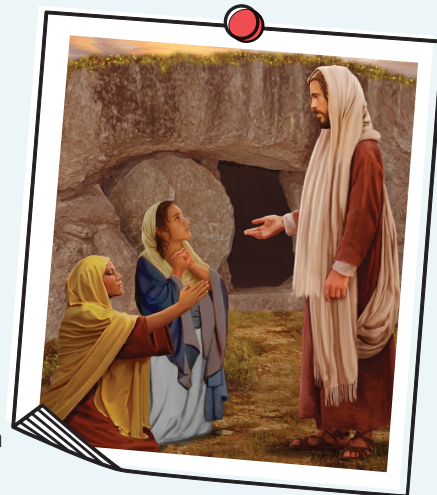
Mary and Mary Magdalene went to the tomb where Jesus was buried. They were sad because Jesus had died.

Jesus Is Alive

MATTHEW 28:1-10

Jesus had died on a cross and had been buried in a tomb. Three days later, Mary and Mary Magdalene went to the tomb where Jesus was buried. They were very sad because Jesus had died.

As they got near the tomb, the ground began to shake. An angel came from heaven. He rolled back the stone in front of the tomb.

The angel told the women, “Do not be afraid. I know you are looking for Jesus. I have good news! He is not here. He is alive!”

The angel told the women to look in the tomb. It was empty! Then the angel told the women to go and tell the disciples (Jesus’ helpers) that Jesus is alive!

The women were happy. They ran to find the disciples so they could tell them the good news.

Suddenly, the two women saw Jesus! They ran to Jesus and worshiped Him.

Jesus said, “Go and tell My disciples to go to Galilee. They will see Me there.” The women ran to tell the disciples the good news.

THE BIBLE MEETS LIFE

Through this Bible story your child learned that Jesus took the punishment for our sins. Jesus died on the cross and three days later rose from the dead. Jesus defeated sin and death for our salvation.



LIVE IT OUT

As you celebrate Easter, help your child understand that Jesus died, and God raised Jesus from the dead. Jesus defeated death and sin to save anyone who believes Him. Help your child memorize Romans 6:23, which explains why Jesus had to die.

Crucifixion and Resurrection

MATTHEW 26:36–28:10

Jesus took His disciples to the garden of Gethsemane. He knew that He was about to die. Three times Jesus prayed, “Father, please let this cup pass from Me. Not My will but Your will be done.”

Suddenly, Judas arrived with a large crowd carrying swords and clubs. Judas kissed Jesus so the crowd would know who Jesus was. The men grabbed Jesus and arrested Him.

Peter, one of Jesus’ disciples, followed Jesus at a distance to the high priest’s courtyard. While Peter waited outside, some people said, “You were with Jesus.” Three times Peter said that he did not know Jesus.

Then the leaders took Jesus to Pilate, the governor. Pilate could not find that Jesus had done anything wrong. He tried to set Jesus free, but the crowds shouted, “Crucify Him!” Pilate agreed to put Jesus to death.

Soldiers beat Jesus, put a robe on Him, and placed a crown of sharp thorns on His head. They led Jesus to a place called Golgotha and nailed Him to a cross. From noon until three in the afternoon, darkness covered the land. Jesus cried out, “My God, My God, why have You forsaken (turned away from) Me?” Soon after, Jesus shouted again with a loud voice, and then He died.

One of the guards said, “This man really was the Son of God!”

That evening Jesus’ body was placed in a tomb and a large stone was rolled against the entrance. Guards were posted to stop anyone from taking His body. But on the third day, guards could not stop the earthquake that shook the ground or the angel who rolled back the stone. The guards were so afraid that they dropped to the ground as if they were dead!

Some women had come to the tomb to care for Jesus’ body. The angel said, “He is not here! He is risen, just as He said! Come and see!”

As the women ran to tell Jesus’ disciples the news, Jesus met them. “Greetings!” Jesus said. The women fell at Jesus’ feet and worshiped Him. Jesus is alive! “Don’t be afraid,” Jesus told them. “Go tell My brothers they will see Me in Galilee.”
