

## Two Men on the Road to Emmaus

### VERSE

Jesus said,  
"Remember Me."

LUKE 22:19

### FOLLOW a Path

Gather several pairs of shoes and place them on the floor, making a path. Place this page at the end of the path. Invite your child to walk along the path made by the shoes. Look at the Bible story picture (reverse side) and talk about how Jesus walked along the road with two men. Mention that the men did not know it was Jesus at first. State that when the men knew it was Jesus, they went to tell their friends that Jesus was alive.

### PLAY a Guessing Game

Gather several easily recognizable items (toy car, small block, spoon, sock) and place in a gift bag. Invite your child to sit on the floor with eyes closed. Place one item at a time in your child's hands guiding them to guess what the item is without looking. Remind your child that the two men did not know Jesus at first. State that when they realized Jesus was with them, they were happy to know He was alive and went to tell other people the good news.

### RECALL Things Jesus Did

Tell the Bible story (reverse side). Say that Jesus walked with the men. Open your Bible and read aloud Luke 24:27. Say that Jesus helped people know what the Scriptures said. Say that Jesus prayed before the meal with the men. Pray with your child.

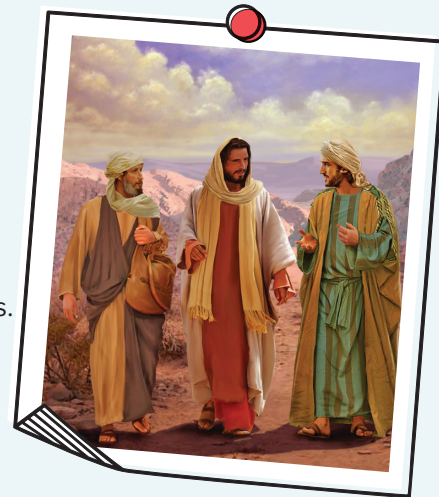

### Babies

Two men walked and talked about Jesus. Jesus joined the men, but they did not know it was Him.

The men stopped to eat. Jesus prayed and gave the men bread. The men then knew it was Jesus.

The men went to tell Jesus' helpers that Jesus was alive—they had seen Him.



### 1s

Two men walked along the road and talked about Jesus.

Another man joined them, but the two men did not know who He was.

The man was Jesus. He talked with the men.

The two men asked Jesus to eat with them.

After the man prayed, the two men saw that He was Jesus.

The men went to tell their friends that Jesus was alive.

### 2s

Two men walked along the road and talked about Jesus.

A man joined them, but the men did not recognize or know that the man was Jesus.

Jesus talked to the men about what the Scriptures said would happen to Jesus.

The men stopped to eat together.

After the man prayed, the two men saw that He was Jesus.

The men returned to Jerusalem to tell that Jesus was alive.

## Two Men on the Road to Emmaus

LUKE 24:13-35

Two men walked to a town near Jerusalem called Emmaus (eh MAY uhs). As they walked, a man joined them.

This man was Jesus, but the men did not know it was Jesus. Jesus asked the men why they were arguing. The men told Jesus what had happened the past few days.

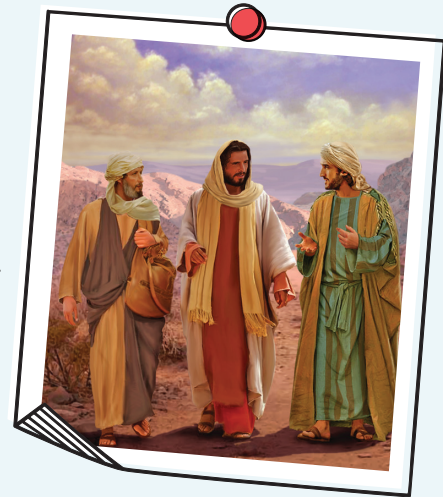
They said, "Jesus did many miracles. We thought He was the person that the prophets said would come. But Jesus died on a cross. Now, three days later, some women went to the tomb where He was buried. It was empty. An angel told them that Jesus was alive!"

Jesus told the men what the Bible said about Him. When they neared Emmaus, the men asked Him to stay with them. He did.

They sat down to eat. Jesus took bread, prayed over it, and tore it to share with the men. Suddenly, the men understood that Jesus was sitting at their table!

The men returned to Jerusalem that night to find Jesus' disciples (helpers). They told the disciples they had seen Jesus. He is alive!

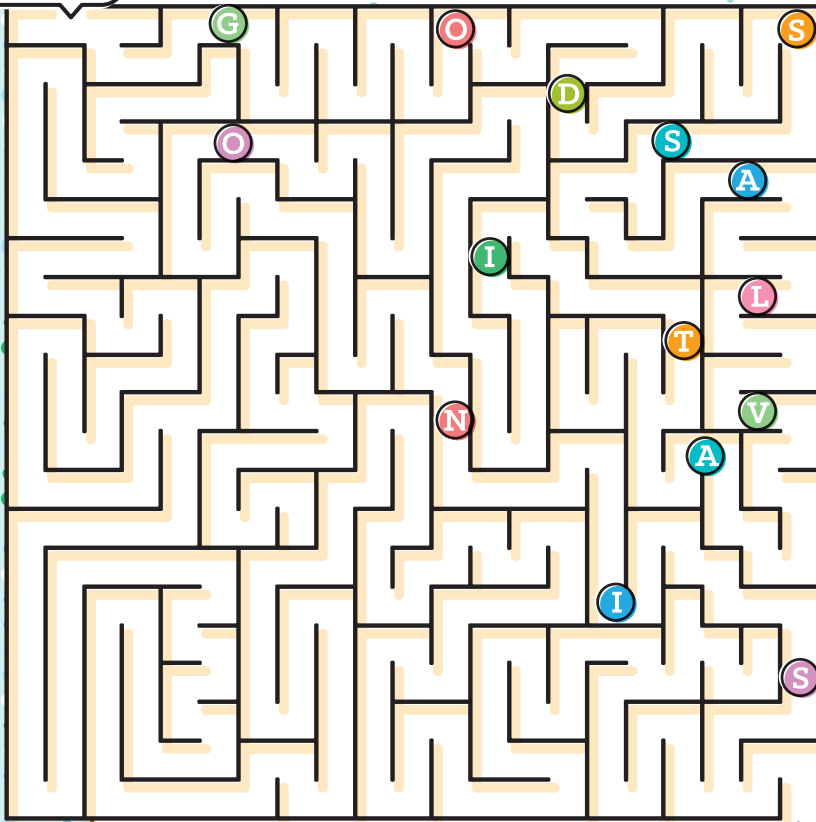

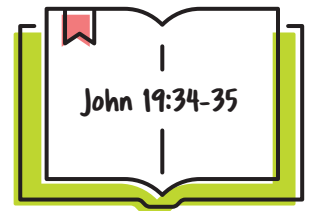
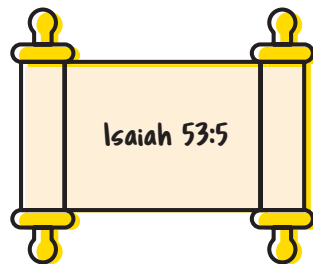

## Two Men on the Road to Emmaus

LUKE 24:13-35

Two of Jesus' disciples were on their way to a village called Emmaus. They were talking about everything that had happened in Jerusalem when Jesus had been crucified. As they were talking, Jesus Himself began to walk with them, but the men did not recognize Him. Jesus asked the men what they were talking about.

"Haven't you heard what has happened these last few days?" one of the men asked Jesus. Jesus replied, "What things?"

The two men shared all that had happened. They explained that Jesus, a Prophet who spoke many things about God, had been handed over by their chief priests to be crucified. The men had hoped that Jesus was the One who was sent to save Israel. Then the men shared that this was not the end of the story. They explained how three days after Jesus had died, women from their group arrived early at the tomb where Jesus had been buried, but Jesus' body was not there. Instead, the women saw angels who told them Jesus was alive!

Jesus listened intently to the disciples' story, and then He said, "Didn't the Scriptures say that the Messiah would have to suffer before entering into His glory?" Then Jesus taught the men everything in the Scriptures that was written about Him.

When they came near the village, the men invited Jesus to stay with them for the night. As Jesus sat at a table with them, He took bread, blessed it, and gave it to the men. When they saw this, the disciples immediately realized that the man was Jesus. At that moment, Jesus disappeared from their sight. The two disciples were amazed. They talked about how their hearts felt like they were on fire when Jesus explained the Scriptures to them.

That very hour, the men got up and returned to Jerusalem. They found Jesus' eleven disciples and shared all that had happened on the road with Jesus. The men exclaimed, "The Lord has certainly been raised from the dead, and He appeared to us this day!"
