

FLOAT Boats

Put water in the sink or plastic tub. Give your child boats to float on the water. Show your child how to make waves with her hands. Do this activity outside where splashing can be part of the fun if possible. Say that Paul sailed on a boat but a storm came and the boat wrecked. Tell the remainder of the Bible story (reverse side). Say: "Everywhere Paul went, he told people about Jesus."

PLAY with a Boat

Place a toy boat near your baby and encourage her to touch or hold it. Comment that the Bible tells us that Paul and some men were sailing on a boat and a storm caused the boat to wreck near an island. Tell the remainder of the Bible story (reverse side). Open your Bible and read aloud: "All God's words are true. Psalm 119:160."

BANDAGE a Doll

Give your child bandages to put on a doll or toy animal. Help wrap gauze or cloth strips around a doll. Read the Bible story (reverse side) and talk about how Paul made sick people well and told them about Jesus. Say: "God wants us to be like Paul and tell people about Jesus."

Paul was a prisoner because he taught about Jesus. A soldier named Julius took Paul onto a ship to travel to Rome. The wind made it difficult to sail.

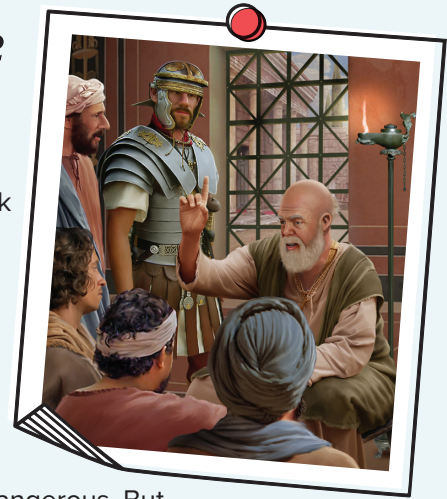

The next morning, the ship hit land and was wrecked. All the men jumped off the ship and floated or swam for the shore. They were on the island of Malta.

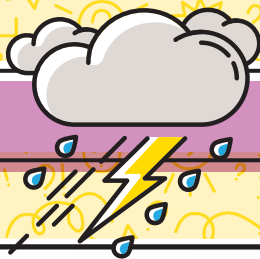

Paul Taught in Rome

ACTS 27-28

Paul had been arrested, and he got on a ship with other prisoners going to Rome. As they sailed, a strong storm began tossing the ship. The ship's crew waited until the wind calmed to sail around the island of Crete, but the strong wind pushed the ship.

The crew pulled the lifeboat on board, so it would not float away. They tied ropes around the ship to hold it together in the storm. The next day the crew threw things overboard. The wind and rain did not stop for many days. The men on the ship were afraid they would die.

One night God sent an angel to Paul. The angel told Paul to not be afraid. God would save the lives of everyone on the ship. Paul told everyone on board, "Take courage, men. I believe God will do what He said. We will not die, but we have to run the ship onto an island."

As the ship drifted toward the island of Malta, some of the sailors tried to escape in the lifeboat. "No," Paul told them, "unless you stay on the ship, you won't be saved." The men listened to Paul and stayed. They cut the ropes of the lifeboat and let it float away. Paul told everyone to eat. He thanked God for the food. Then the crew raised the sails and headed toward the beach on the island.

Suddenly, the ship struck a sandbar and stopped moving. Waves crashed into the ship, and it began to break into pieces. An officer ordered everyone to swim to the shore. Some swam and others clung to pieces of the ship. They all made it safely to shore! God saved all of their lives!

The people on the island built a fire for them. As Paul gathered firewood, a snake bit his hand. The people thought he was a murderer and would die from the snake. When nothing happened, they decided Paul was a god. Paul healed a man, and others came to be healed, too.

Three months later, Paul continued his journey and sailed to Rome. Finally, they arrived in Rome! Paul was still a prisoner, but instead of going to jail, he was allowed to live in his own rented house. A soldier stayed with him to guard him. Paul lived in the house for two years and welcomed anyone who visited him. All day he told his visitors about the kingdom of God and tried to persuade them to believe in Jesus.
