# When a crisis hits someone in our church family, we rally.

Since 2003, our church has committed to "doing good to all people, especially to those who belong to the family of believers, as you have opportunity" (Galatians 6:10). This support can be spiritual, emotional, relational, and even financial.

Each year about 100 CTK families experience a financial crisis, usually due to a sudden loss, injury, or tragedy. Our Blessing Coordinator is at the ready to come alongside, help them access community resources and find ways your collective generosity can fill in the holes. It's a beautiful thing to be part of God's answers to a fellow CTKers prayers for help.

# Sharing food to bring hope to our hungry neighbors

Local food banks tell us the needs are rising steadily over the last few years. Our Food Share ministry works with our partners to adapt to the need as it grows and changes shape. Each year our team oversees the planning and daily tasks needed to grow about 50 tons of produce, collect thousands of non-perishable items through our

Item of the Month club and local businesses, then drive that food all over Whatcom County to our 32 different partner locations.



In addition to meeting local food needs, we also have created a space for learning and collaboration with other organizations and schools. Here are some new ways we've been impacting our community:

- Over 300 students from 6 different schools came to the farm to serve, learn and harvest
- Our partners have sent teams of people to help work in the fields, connect with our team, and join us in prayer
- We've explored delivering to housing providers and setting up food stands with other nonprofit partners as two ways to reach people who can't access food banks

We've always believed that our impact would come through not just the food we share but also through



our people living out their faith. Ultimately our work is our testimony, and the community is noticing!

The Response Teams ministry is focused on responding to the practical needs of our community partners. But we aren't just throwing people at a project. One of the most important aspects of Response Teams is the unique opportunity to express our faith, our hope, putting the love of Christ into action.

The goal with Response Teams is to come alongside our partners and the work they're already doing in the community. We want to meet their specific needs and let them be the experts while we are the hands and feet supporting them.

Often, our projects create mental and literal space, easing the burden of lingering projects so our partners can focus on the important work they are committed to. Filling those gaps is our specialty!

# Projects and funds that meet unique partner needs

Every year since 2016, we've had opportunities to go above and beyond the financial support of the nonprofits we partner with or the service projects we've planned for them. # Linking arms to keep families off the streets

One of our community partners, Lydia Place, helps us understand the complexity of what puts families on the streets and what keeps them there. As they focus on upstream interventions and nurturing whole-family healing to disrupt the generational cycle of poverty and homelessness, we look for ways God has uniquely graced us to support their important work and the 300+ families they serve each year.

We're really excited to try something new with them in 2025: the purchase and support of a tiny home embedded in a new development off East Bellis Fair Parkway where a recently homeless family can stay until they get on their feet. In addition to the case management, parenting support, and in-home mental health care Lydia Place provides, CTK will commit to supporting the family who lives there in tangible ways.
