Did you see that? We have everything we need for a godly life through the promises of God. And when we add goodness, knowledge, self-control, perseverance, godliness, mutual affection and love to our faith, the world around us can be changed!







CTK Global Partner Focus: India

Carrying the Gospel to 23 million people... by bike!

OUR CTK GLOBAL PARTNER IN INDIA

is working alongside an indigenous ministry which has been sharing Jesus in a very populous state. Most of the people are Hindu, animists, and Muslim. Few know about or follow Jesus, making the harvest exceedingly plentiful and the darkness great. The focused area of outreach has a population of over 23 million people. Our partner's goal is to reach all of them.

But how can so few believers reach 23 million people with the gospel? Facing this seemingly impossible mission, the ministry leader has taken a different perspective, preferring to drive his stake into the truth that God is bigger than the odds.

By carefully mapping out the area and calculating what it would take to get the job done, he estimates that 300 missionaries working full-time for four years will be able to go to every village and each house in this vast outreach area, giving residents a Gospel of Luke or John. Said differently, these 300 missionaries, working in the context of teams, will target 4.6 million homes



over the course of 48 months, with the goal of giving one Gospel to each home. Much of the their travel will be by bike. And thanks to your generosity during Missions Month in March, at least one of these teams of 10 has been fully funded for one year.

Wow...talk about vision! Pray for this massive undertaking, that God's

Word would be shared with millions of people, and many would come to know Jesus as their Savior!
