Pastor Nelson Sneed

Nelson Sneed was born in Mecklenburg County, Virginia near the town of Clarksville. He is the fifth of ten children born to Robert and Annie Mae Sneed. He is married

to Sara Sneed and they have three wonderful adult children, and six dynamic grandchildren. He joined the Davis Chapel Baptist Church in Stovall, NC at a young age. In January 1979, he joined the Mount Pleasant Baptist Church (MPBC) located in Alexandria, VA.
