“This is a ministry within the church body for the military – often the context of services is confidential as we in the military are very “private” in most aspects of life.

As an Elder of the church and retired military it has been a ministry on our hearts (my wife & I) for many years. My last program of study was in psychology, and I am a graduate of AACC in Counseling. Thus, the name of the ministry is “Operation Reinforcement” as when we (military) are in a bind we look for reinforcements of our own.” – Mark Gyure

This ministry is focused on serving our military / veterans and their families under the principal found in Philippians 2:1-5

"So, if there is any encouragement in Christ, any comfort from love, any participation in the Spirit, any affection and sympathy, complete my joy by being of the same mind, having the same love, being in full accord and of one mind. Embrace Grace

This ministry group supports women walking through an unexpected pregnancy, women navigating single motherhood and young men embarking the journey of fatherhood by connecting them to a judgment-free support group within a church. Contact Caitlyn Harward: cebradham@gmail.com

“Embrace Grace is a 12 week long support group for single women experiencing unexpected pregnancy offered under the cover of the church. The curriculum is designed to explore their identity in Christ as women and what that means as they become mothers. Once the 12 weeks are concluded, we throw a baby shower for the women where we strive to provide them with most, if not all, of their registry items. We partner with the Life Care Pregnancy Center who advertise our group by purchasing Love Boxes from the Embrace Grace website and gifting one to each woman they serve. Each Love Box has a personal invitation to a church-hosted support group, stories from both a parenting mom and birth mom, a letter of hope, a journal with writing prompts encouraging her to be fearless, a ‘Best Gift Ever’ onesie and A Bump in Life book that includes testimonies that offer single and pregnant moms hope. Some women we have in our Embrace Grace group are abortion-minded, some are not, some are single, and some have boyfriends, but they all are experiencing an unexpected pregnancy and are in desperate need of the love and grace Christ wants to freely give them.

I chose to start Embrace Grace at NCF because God gave me His heart for women and girls going through an unexpected pregnancy. They are, at times, paralyzed with fear, and are convinced by the world and abortion industry that they are either incapable of raising their child, or that their dreams stop when the child is born. We, as Christians, know this is a lie propagated by the devil to oppress women and murder innocent babies while still in the womb. When I came across Embrace Grace online, I felt the Holy Spirit affirm the mission of partnering with our pregnancy centers to bring these women into the church where they can have true support and fellowship in Christ.”

Operation Christmas Child

The mission of Operation Christmas Child is to demonstrate God's love in a tangible way to children in need around the world. Through this project, Samaritan's Purse partners with the local church worldwide to share the Good News of Jesus Christ and make disciples of the nations. This whole process is made possible by caring individuals who pack shoeboxes full of quality gifts for children in need. Many of these shoebox packers also use our Follow Your Box feature to discover the country where their gift will be delivered.

More than 10,000 year-round volunteers also get the word out about the Samaritan's Purse project across the U.S. In addition, some 82,000 short-term volunteers serve in more than 4,500 drop-off locations open across the country every year during National Collection Week, the third week in November. Each shoebox collected then travels to one of our processing centers to be inspected and prepared for international shipment by 105,000 volunteers. All of this is supported by the 14,000 volunteers in our prayer network.

NCF is part of these faithful volunteers. Each year NCF is a regional drop off location for our surrounding area. We collect hundreds of shoeboxes and help ship them to their next location along the journey. Children all over the world are receiving the love of Christ because of volunteers like you! Ashton's House of Hope

A children's home built in memory of Karen and Jeff Leenheer's daughter Ashton Taylor who passed away in 2019. The house is located in Kenya and currently houses 5 children but has room for up to 8. It is a place for children to live who are orphaned or are in a situation where their parents cannot provide for them. Each child that lives at Ashton's House is enrolled in school. There are house parents on site who cook and clean and takes care of all the children's needs.



Mama Wilfreda's Orphanage & Technical School

Mama Wilfreda's Orphanage is run by Samson and Betty Nyameche. There are two main homes on campus, each housing up to 60 children. At the orphanage, education is a HUGE part of their mission. They take in school-aged children from 5 years old and up.

A technical school has recently been added to their facility to instruct students who have aged out of the orphanage in a trade or skill in which to make a living by. Some common trades learned here: welding, electrical work, I.T. support, tailoring, etc.

NCF has developed a child sponsorship program to help the orphaned children further their education. The cost to sponsor a child is \$300 per year. This sponsorship helps, clothe, feed and educate the children.

Nairobi Believers Mission

A church located in Nairobi, Kenya, a city with over a million people. Many people lack employment, safe housing, nutrition and education. As a result, the crime rate, drug use, broken families, alcoholism, sexual immorality and violence have all increased in Nairobi.

Believers Fellowships mission is to influence families and their communities for transformation through Christ.

Isaiah 61:1-3 “The Spirit of the Sovereign Lord is on me because the Lord has anointed me to proclaim good news to the poor. He has sent me to bind up the brokenhearted, to proclaim freedom for the captives and release from the darkness for the prisoners, to proclaim the year of the Lord’s favor and the day of vengeance of our God, to comfort all who mourn, and provide for those who grieve in Zion – to bestow on them a crown of beauty instead of ashes, the oil of joy instead of mourning, and a garment of praise instead of a spirit of despair. They will be called oaks of righteousness, a planting of the Lord for the display of His splendor.

Programs that Nairobi Believers Mission offers:

- Planting vegetable gardens with women in the community to help feed their families
- Teach women to make clothes
- Intentional time in prayer as a church body
- Baby showers & wedding showers
- Kids ministry: Sunday school, VBS, providing a place for children to come play & get a meal



Milele Center for Orphans in Kenya

Tabasumu Watoto Inclusive Center

This community-based organization is in the Kibera Slums of Nairobi. They are dedicated to improving educational opportunities and financial stability for families and children made vulnerable by poverty and issues of special needs and/or disabilities. They do this by working with families, community leaders and educators to obtain resources, eliminate stigma and find support for families and special needs children.

Overall, Special Needs Education has been a seriously neglected part of the education landscape here in Kenya. The society for lack of awareness still believe that disabled people bring bad luck because they have been cursed or have had a spell placed upon them by witchcraft. Additionally, persons with disabilities are often viewed as not fully human or possessed by evil spirits. This makes it easy to stigmatize, make fun of or ridicule them and their families. Since being founded in 2011, we have worked with over 200 families by operating different programs to increase access to children with special needs in Kibera.

Some of our Programs offered:

- An Inclusive Early Childhood Program
- Cheka Momma Income Generating/Group Savings and Loan Projects: Parents at the center learn different skills to help become self-supporting and provide for themselves and their families. All parents also meet once a week to save money in which they can borrow small amounts on flexible terms. At the end of the year, all money is returned to parents with interest earned
- Special Needs Outreach Program: Organized outreach programs for all community members to educate and de-stigmatize about special needs
- Girls Project: Tabasumu gives girls a physical and emotional safe space to express themselves and discuss topics that are unique to women in Kibera

Pregnancy Resource Center in Romania

This mission is run by Milan & Misty Mihai. Misty's heart is to serve the moms and children of their village while Milan disciples the men of the village. Please read more about each mission below.

Mom's Garden is a Pregnancy Resource Center (PRC). Our mission is to support families and single parents as they raise their children while we attempt to draw the family closer to Christ. Mom's Garden was pioneered by Misty & Oana in 2018 and at that time it was the first PRC of its kind in all of Romania. Since 2018, we have served over 130 families, 120 children and 90 children have been born while their parents were part of our center. Each week we serve 25 families, including over 40 children.



The Bridge is a discipleship program that builds a connection between Jesus, men and our community. Integrating broken men back into our society as transformed individuals. "The Bridge" aims to provide more than just spiritual guidance, it seeks to empower individuals by addressing their practical needs and helping them overcome societal barriers. Through faith, community and hard work, we believe that we can create lasting change and help individuals discover their God-given potential.



Chance Walters Ministries

Reverend Chance Walters is a Full-time Missionary Evangelist who has preached the Gospel in 34 Countries and 49 States. After God radically set Him free from drug and alcohol addiction in 2003, he forsook everything to follow Jesus. After serving in various capacities in the church, he founded Chance Walters Ministries International to host crusades, pastors conferences and outreaches in some of the most unreached areas of the world. He also travels extensively across America speaking in local churches, conferences and schools. Chance is married to his best friend, Kacie, and they have 4 beautiful kids residing in Greensboro, North Carolina.

Haiti Help and Hope

Haiti Help and Hope (HHH) is a nonprofit organization formed in 2016 composed of Christian brothers and sisters from across the Moore County community. Members visit and are engaged in the work and planning of the ministry with Pastor Sidor and his wife Lillian. This ministry serves 4 churches and Lahai Roi School of over 400 students in. The people of Haiti are desperately in need of help spiritually and physically. Pastor Sidor, originally from Haiti, was burdened by the quality of life of the Haitian people. He and his wife Lillian left the comfort of the United States to go back to his native land and serve in the village and surrounding areas of Montrouis, Haiti. The goal of HHH is to be the hands and feet of Jesus in a hurting world and to spread the GOOD NEWS OF the Gospel of Jesus Christ.

Pastor Sidor is kicking off a new school year at the Christian school in Haiti. With the help of several donors, he was able to build some new, much needed classrooms for the school. He held a parent and teacher prayer meeting for the school year this week.

Against all odds, and with God's hand of protection and blessing, they are providing physical and spiritual food for the children in the mountain village of Duclos. Pastor Sidor and the ministry continues to keep their eyes on Jesus as they navigate the evil of gangs and lawlessness on a daily basis. The harsh reality of daily life has not changed. Sidor is a bold warrior for the Gospel and a humble servant for the Kingdom. He gives ALL the honor and glory to God for the things he is able to accomplish. NAOMI House operates on an emergency, front-line basis. That is, providing food, clothing, shelter, safety, and prayer, on-call, as the need arises.

Sustaining and expanding our current vehicle of safe houses is *vital and important* to the big picture. A young adult program would help many from falling through the cracks after, oftentimes, a lifetime in the foster care system.

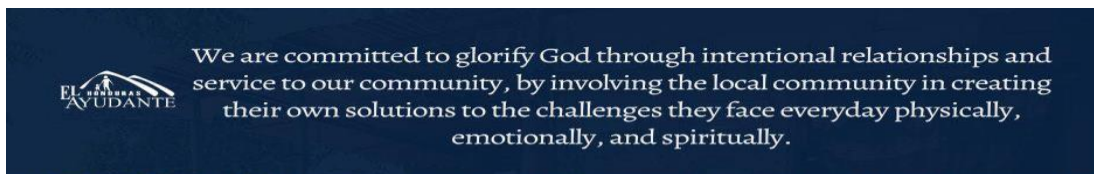


El Ayudante

What started as one man's vision to meet the physical and spiritual needs in Honduras, Mel Cox followed the Lord's guidance and founded El Ayudante in 1998.

El Ayudante lives by its vision of "Changing Lives and Transforming Communities". They are committed to glorifying God through intentional relationships and service to Honduras communities. This is done through their mission of "Growing Committed Followers of Jesus Christ by Meeting the Needs of their Communities".

El Ayudante aims to empower and enable by collaborating with families, churches, and local leaders for the long term. They use short term mission teams to meet the needs of communities. Because of consistent involvement, a short-term project, such as building a pila, building a latrine, building an adobe home, laying a concrete floor, or installing water filter system in a home, is a part of a lasting, long term change. This long-term change results in such things as marriage ceremonies, counseling, leaders in local churches, and womens' conferences, just to name a few. They have also expanded to a full-time medical clinic and learning center on campus. All of these are just the seeds in making disciples of Christ to the world!



Servants for His Kingdom

Servants for His Kingdom was founded in 2022 by Eric Payne to support the needs of our brothers and sisters left with little hope. Eric dedicated his life to missionary discipleship after a spiritual awakening opened his heart to the spiritual needs of this world. Eric gave away his earthly belongings and desires to take up the Great Commission and devote his life to the Lord Jesus Christ. Eric began his journey in Kentucky after the Dawson Springs tornado disaster in 2021 left thousands without food and shelter. 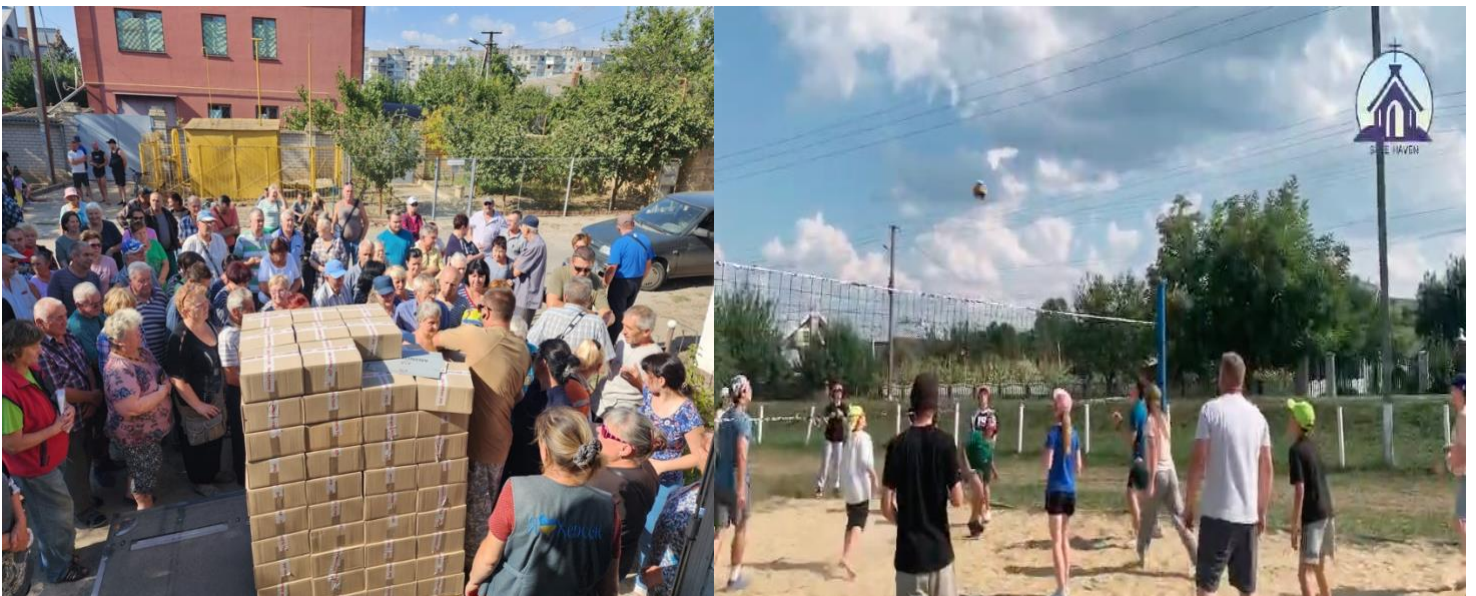
Mission

Nepal Mission

Nepal Mission is a ministry that was started in 2009 to reach out with the love of the Lord to the poor and disabled of Nepal. They have over the years expanded this ministry to include Hope House, a refuge for children and youth, several active home fellowships and two churches, outreaches to many remote villages and ongoing ministry to all who come to their door and many they are sent to.
