Recent updates have focused on strengthening the building and preparing key spaces for the next phase of work. Schedule

March brought continued progress to the renovation at Grace Evangelical Lutheran Church. Crews completed the underground electrical work and installed the new CT cabinet, while the new steel stair was also set in place. In the sanctuary, new electrical units were installed, work began on connecting power to the new main electrical panel, and framing started for the new chapel ceiling.



Looking ahead to April and May, several important milestones are planned. Crews will install the floor underlayment, transition power to the new electrical system, and begin work on the new EPDM roof. Additional rooftop improvements will include new steel support framing and installation of a new mechanical unit. In the GMOC kitchen, a new concrete floor will also be poured as work continues to move the project forward.
