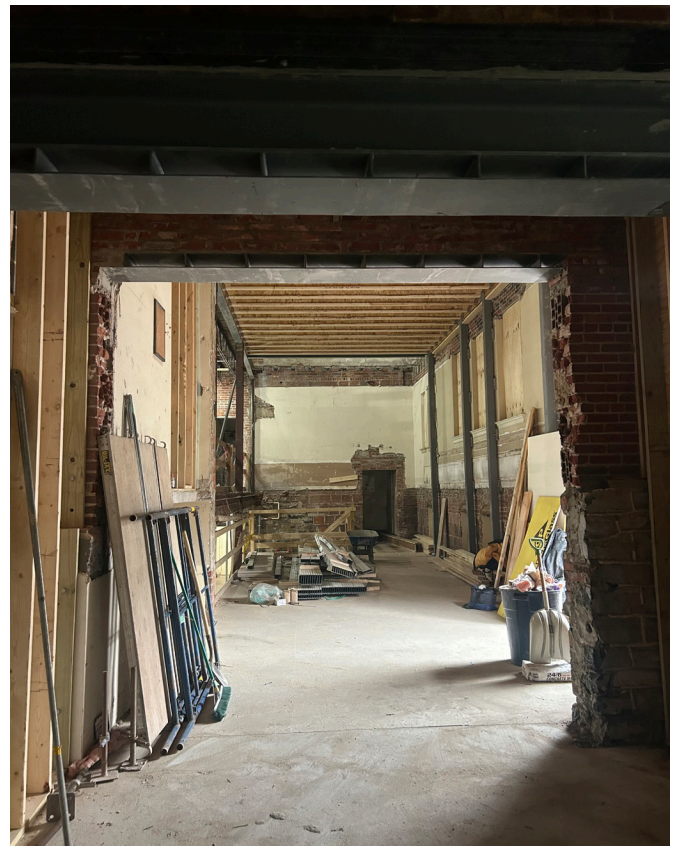
Schedule

January brought steady progress to the renovation at Grace Evangelical Lutheran Church. Crews completed framing the connector that links the renovated areas to the sanctuary and began shaping new interior spaces with additional framing work.

Mechanical, electrical, and plumbing systems also began to take shape inside the building, and insulation was installed in the roof area to prepare for future finishes. New electrical equipment was set in place, and framing began for the new wheelchair lift, helping improve accessibility within the church.

Looking ahead to February, interior work will continue with drywall installation and additional insulation throughout the building. The team will also begin demolition work in the kitchen area, trenching for a new electrical service line, and starting installation of the new roof.
