Recent work has focused on completing key interior installations that improve both the functionality and accessibility of the facility. Schedule

In July, crews completed several important interior milestones, including installation of the fire curtain, kitchen casework, bathroom tile, wheelchair lift, and kitchen coiling door. These improvements represent significant progress toward completing the building's primary gathering spaces while enhancing accessibility and daily operations.

In August, work will continue with the installation of paint, additional casework, ceiling grid and tile systems, flooring, and bathroom accessories. Together, these finishes will further transform the interior spaces and bring the renovation another step closer to completion.
