

Shaping What's Ahead


As construction continues at Grace Evangelical Lutheran Church, the project is entering another meaningful stage of transformation. Progress on the interior and exterior is becoming more noticeable, and our team remains committed to carrying out each step with care, safety, and respect for the church community. We appreciate the ongoing support from the congregation as we work toward restoring the spaces that will serve Grace for many years to come.

Schedule

November brought significant progress to the renovation work at Grace Evangelical Lutheran Church. Crews finished re-decking the first floor and installed the new steel wind columns, which play an important role in strengthening the building for the future. Work also began on temporary shoring inside the church to support upcoming renovations, and trenching for the new sanitary plumbing was completed.

Looking ahead to December, the team will begin framing the ground-floor lobby and starting the light-gauge framing that will help define new interior spaces. The underground sanitary work will be completed, and new concrete will be poured over the updated line. Together, these efforts continue to shape the renewed worship and gathering spaces, bringing this vision for Grace closer to reality.
