Day Trip

Description:

Come join us for a day and experience the Nations living in the Metro DC area. We will gather together for a time of training, prayer, and break out into teams of 2-3 people as we head into strategic areas. You will visit ethnic markets and restaurants being exposed to the tastes and smells of the Middle East.

Cost: \$40 - \$60 + Gas

We encourage people to plan on \$15 to \$25 per meal plus any snacks trinkets you want to buy to bless the shop owners, as well as to take home an item or two that will remind you to continue praying for the Muslims living in NOVA. For a Day Trip plan to eat lunch and dinner in the community. Please estimate your gas for traveling from your home to our meeting destination. Come expecting a team could easily drive locally 50 to 100 miles per vehicle for a Day Trip. In some locations there could be parking fees.

Age Range:

All ages are welcome! Arab culture is very family friendly and so are we. For families coming with younger kids or infants we could discuss this on a case by case basis. It is a beautiful picture to see families reaching families and God often uses children to gain access to locations and people. This does need to be something planned ahead for because teams with young children would have special assignments.

Attire:

Men: Khakis or jeans are fine. No shorts. Collared shirt preferred and must have sleeves. No shirts with Christian messages.

<u>Women:</u> Loose fitting clothes. Shirts must sleeves and to elbow is best. No shorts. Pants and skirts must be below the knee and the longer the better.

Child Safety Training:

Everyone ages will need to complete a required Child Protection Training prior to serving. More info will be given in the Reaching the Nations Pre-Trip Packet.
