Title: Humbly Sacrificially Serve

Scripture: John 13:1-20

2024 Memory Verses:

January"14 If I then, your Lord and Teacher, have washed your feet, <u>you also ought to wash one another's feet</u>. 15 For I have given you an example, that <u>you also should do just as I have done to you.</u> 16 Truly, truly, I say to you, a servant is not greater than his master, nor is a messenger greater than the one who sent him. 17 If you know these things, blessed are you if you do them." John 13:14-17 ESV

- 1. Jesus knows everything! (John 13:1-3)
 - a. Salvation. (his hour had come to depart out of this world to the Father)
 - b. Love. (having loved his own who were in the world, he loved them to the end)
 - c. The devil and his schemes. (<u>the devil had already put it into the heart of Judas</u> *Iscariot, Simon's son, to betray him*)
 - d. Authority. (the Father had given all things into his hands)
 - e. Control. (that he had come from God and was going back to God)
 - f. Identity. (that he had come from God and was going back to God)
- 2. Jesus humbly and sacrificially serves. (John 13:4-5)
 - a. Laid aside his glory.
 - b. Took on humility.
 - c. Tied humility to himself.
 - d. Sacrificially served those around him.



- 3. We must receive sacrificial service from Jesus. (John 13:6-11)
 - a. Get over discomfort. ("Lord, do you wash my feet?")
 - b. Do not reject Jesus' redemptive love. ("If I do not wash you, you have no share with me.")
 - c. Do not confuse sanctification with justification or growth with salvation. (<u>"The one who has bathed does not need to wash, except for his feet, but is completely clean.</u>

 <u>And you are clean, but not every one of you."</u>)
 - d. Understand the gospel and that not everyone who hears it will receive it. (<u>"the one who has bathed does not need to wash, except for his feet, but is completely clean.</u>

 <u>And you are clean, but not every one of you."</u>)
- 4. We must keep straight Jesus is the Lord and we are the servants. (John 13:12-13)
 - a. Jesus put his glory back on.
 - b. Jesus is at the right hand of God the Father.
 - c. Jesus is interceding for us and He wants us to know it. (Rom. 8:34)
 - d. Jesus served us in humility and He is serving us in glory.
- 5. We must humbly and sacrificially serve just like our Lord and Teacher Jesus. (John 13:14-20)
 - a. We humbly and sacrificially serve our family, the church, and the lost. (v. 14)
 - b. We follow Jesus' Word and example in every sphere of life. (v. 15)
 - c. We keep our pride in check by constantly looking to Jesus and serving one another. (v. 16)
 - d. We will be blessed by God if we humbly and sacrificially serve. (v. 17)
 - e. We will be persecuted by others if we humbly and sacrificially serve. (vs. 18-19)
 - f. We send others to do the same. (v. 20)

Response & Invitation -

- 1. Get identity with Jesus and yourself settled in the truth.
- 2. Remind yourself the Lord is Jesus and you are His servant.
- 3. Decide that you will humbly and sacrificially serve like Jesus.
 - a. Wherever He tells me to go, whatever He tells me to do.
