

Series: Jesus Is (54) Title: Jesus Prays for You Scripture: John 17:1-26

2024 Memory Verses: Theme Verse: 34 A new commandment I give to you, that you love one another: just as I have loved you, you also are to love one another. 35 By this all people will know that you are my disciples, if you have love for one another." John 13:34–35 ESV March: "I have said these things to you, that in me you may have peace. In the world you will have tribulation. But take heart; I have overcome the world." John 16:33 ESV

- 1. Jesus prayed for Himself. (John 17:1-5)
  - a. Common misconceptions:
    - Prayer is only for others: I am not supposed to pray for myself.
    - Prayer is only for me: I do not pray for others. ii.
  - b. What Jesus prayed:
    - The Glory of God in His life. (vs. 1, 4-5)
    - ii. The Gospel to be heard and believed. (vs. 2-4)
  - c. How we should pray:
    - i. For God to be glorified in our lives.
    - ii. For the gospel to be heard and believed.
- 2. Jesus prayed for His disciples. (John 17:6-19)
  - a. Common misconceptions:
    - Prayer is only asking God for things. i.
    - Prayer is only telling God things.
  - b. What Jesus prayed:
    - The power of God's Word working in the world. (vs. 6-9)
    - ii. His disciples to experience the power of God in Jesus' name. (vs. 10-12)
      - 1. Keep them from division, error, evil, and hypocrisy. (vs. 10-16)
      - 2. Sanctify them in the truth (unity with one another). (vs. 17-19)
      - 3. Send them to take the truth of Jesus to the World. (vs. 18-19)
  - c. How we should pray:
    - For the power of God's Word to work in us and the church.
    - Keep me in unity with God, God's Word, and God's church. ii.
    - iii. Sanctify (grow) me in the truth.
    - iv. Send me to my neighbors and the nations with the Gospel.





- 3. Jesus prays for you! (John 17:20-26)
  - a. Common misconceptions:
    - i. Prayer is remote and inaccessible.
    - ii. Prayer is not effective. It's a last ditch effort.
  - b. What Jesus prayed:
    - i. For you to know Jesus, the Gospel, and to be saved! (vs. 20, 23, 25)
    - ii. For you to know that God loves you like He loves Jesus. (vs. 23, 26)
    - iii. For you to be in close fellowship with God and the church. (vs. 21-26)
  - c. How we should pray:
    - i. Confess Jesus as Lord and repent of my sin. (v. 21)
    - ii. Help me to love others so that they will believe the Gospel. (vs. 23, 26)
    - iii. Help me to love God, my family, the church, and the lost selflessly and sacrificially.
