

Series: Jesus Is (57)
Title: Jesus is in Control
Scripture: John 18:1-18

2024 Memory Verses: Theme Verse: 34 A new commandment I give to you, that you love one another: just as I have loved you, you also are to love one another. 35 By this all people will know that you are my disciples, if you have love for one another." **John 13:34–35 ESV April:** "17 Sanctify them in the truth; your word is truth. 18 As you sent me into the world, so I have sent them into the world." **John 17:7-8 ESV**

- 1. Jesus is the Sovereign Savior who is in control. (vs. 1-2)
 - a. Jesus is the fulfillment of the Passover. (v. 1)
 - i. Jesus is perfectly leading.
 - ii. Jesus is the Perfect Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world in the valley of the shadow of death. (Psalm 23:4)
 - b. Jesus is the redemption in the garden. (vs. 1-2)
 - i. Jesus reversed the curse (Eden). (Gen. 2:17, 3:6-7, 17-19; John 11:25-26)
 - ii. Jesus was crushed for our iniquities (Gethsemane). (Isaiah 53:5-6, 10)
- 2. Jesus is the Almighty God who has power over all people. (vs. 3-11)
 - a. The "I AM" knocks His enemies to the ground. (vs. 3-6, Psalm 27:1-2)
 - b. The "I AM" shelters and protects His followers. (vs. 7-9; Psalm 46:1; 2 Thess. 3:3)
 - c. The "I AM" heals and restores the wounded. (v. 10, Luke 22:51)
 - d. The "I AM" calms the restless soul and gives purpose and mission. (v. 11, John 10:17-18)
- 3. Jesus is the Prince of Peace working redemption amidst corruption and sin. (vs. 12-18)
 - a. While corrupt men were scheming, Jesus was redeeming. (vs. 12-14; Genesis 50:20)
 - b. While close men were denying, Jesus was protecting them. (vs. 15-18)

One takeaway: Who and what am I seeking? (John 18:4-8; 1:38; Jeremiah 29:12-14)
