Title: God Opposes the Proud, but Gives Grace to the Humble

Scripture: Esther 6-7

**2025** Theme Scripture: Romans 1:16-17 (ESV) For I am not ashamed of the gospel, for it is the power of God for salvation to everyone who believes, to the Jew first and also to the Greek. For in it the righteousness of God is revealed from faith for faith, as it is written, "The righteous shall live by faith."

March Scripture Memory: Proverbs 16:18 (ESV) "Pride goes before destruction, and a haughty spirit before a fall." 1 Peter 5:6 (ESV) "Humble yourselves, therefore, under the mighty hand of God so at the proper time he may exalt you."

- 1) The providence of God is an unstoppable <u>force</u>. (6:1-5) God is providential over human events (seen in Xerxes):
  - 1. His insomnia
  - 2. His choice of entertainment (having someone read a book)
  - 3. The servant's choice of books
  - 4. The king's delay in regarding/rewarding Mordecai

GOD's DELAYS are NOT God's DENIALS.

5. The Timely arrival of Haman

"There is no wisdom or understanding Or counsel against the LORD." (Proverbs 21:30 NKJV) "The LORD brings the counsel of the nations to nothing; He makes the plans of the peoples of no effect. The counsel of the LORD stands forever, The plans of His heart to all generations." (Psalm 33:10-11 NKJV)
