Title: The Gospel for ALL of Life

Scripture: Romans 1

April Memory Verse & 2025 Theme Scripture: Romans 1:16-17 (ESV) For I am not ashamed of the gospel, for it is the power of God for salvation to everyone who believes, to the Jew first and also to the Greek. For in it the righteousness of God is revealed from faith for faith, as it is written, "The righteous shall live by faith."

The Gospel reveals who Jesus is:

- The Son of God in POWER (fully God) (v. 3)
- Descended from King David (fully Man) (v. 4)
- Resurrected from the Dead through the Holy Spirit (v. 4)
- The Lord (vs. 4, 6)
- King of the nations (v. 5)

How do you see Jesus?

- How we see Jesus must be based on what the Word teaches us.
- How we see Jesus determines how we see ourselves.

* Paul knew who he was in Christ:

- Slave of Christ Jesus (v. 1)
- Called to be an apostle (v. 1)
- Set apart for the gospel (v. 1) (EVERYTHING IS ABOUT THE GOSPEL).

The Gospel reveals who we are in Christ:

- Saved by Grace (v. 5)
- I am a Sent One by God (v. 5)
- Purposed by God (v. 5)
 - Living for the sake of the name of Jesus
- Belong to Christ (v. 6)
- Loved by God (v. 7)
- Call to be a Saint (v. 7)



How do you see yourself?

- How we see ourselves must be based on what the Word teaches us.
- How we see ourselves determines how we live.

The Gospel reveals how we should live:

- Thank God for one another. (gratitude) (v. 8)
- Pray for one another without ceasing. (v. 9)
- Gather with the body regularly to strengthen and mutually encourage each other. (v. 12)
- Preach the gospel to one another. (v. 15)
- Take the gospel to the nations. (v. 14)
