How big is your God?

Psalm 22.3, like a rose among thorns, says of God, “*Yet You are holy, enthroned on the praises of Israel.*” Exalting God in the language of praise is the “rose.” The “thorns” are the Psalmist’s (David’s!) words, before and after the praise, questioning God’s seeming indifference and the scorn heaped upon those who trust in God. The Psalms teach us, over and over again, to return to the greatness of God. We need to continually affirm His glorious nature, His awesome character.


This week, on Wednesday, **Psalm 93** does exactly that.

Psalm 93 is an unfettered Psalm of praise acknowledging the greatness of God. God’s marvelous attributes provide the trellis upon which the vines of our worship - personal & congregational - grow over a lifetime. The end result is never to be in doubt. God will be glorified! Like floods come and go, the rainy seasons and the drought of man’s affairs will also come and go. God will be glorified!

I’m neither a mariner nor the son of one. Yet I found a bit of sailing wisdom. “Ships don’t go down because of the water around them. They go down because of the water that gets in them.” It is always tempting to fear being drowned by the swirl of events that constantly deluge me. But my faith stays alive and vital by constantly focusing on the certainty of God.
