Imagine if, on your first day in the first grade, an educator backed a truck onto your front lawn. Imagine every book and item to be used for the next 12 to 16 to ... who knows how many ... years of your future education filled the bed of the truck. Imagine seeing all of that unloaded on your driveway before your six-year-old eyes. Then imagine being told: "Welcome to school. You need to learn all of this." Would your six-year-old self feel overwhelmed? Would you panic? Would you reflexively blurt, "I can't do that! I don't want to do that!"

It is almost a temptation to view the Psalms as too much. What are we to make of a book within an even longer book?

View the Psalms as more to be lived over a lifetime than learned in a month, or a year. Many enjoy our Thanksgiving meal as a blessing for the time spent with others. But the food does matter, right? Do you eat the same food(s) for Thanksgiving? In your memory have some Thanksgivings been great while others ... not so much? Yet, lovely or lousy in any given year, you keep going back to the meal year after year. The Psalms are experiences to be visited and re-visited. They are meals to be repeatedly savored.

Psalm 117 is a pleasing, brief "meal" of praise. It is the shortest Psalm. Feast on it often.
