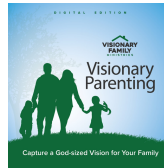

This week in the Psalms: 1-5
"The Psalms provide the language of life with God."

This statement introduces the guide which will take the reader through the Psalms in 2024. Many plans exist for reading the Psalms. For example, reading three Psalms a day allows for moving through the Psalms twice in the year. I encourage you cultivate familiarity with the Psalms, regardless of the plan you may choose.

Why? Many people, myself included, struggle to find words either explaining or expressing daily life with God. Some days are great, most are routine, some are confusing and a few are quite grim. Yet all of life needs to be lived fully in the presence of God.

The Psalms, I have found, provide a needed resource for such a life. Sometimes I understand, sometimes I don't. But, over time, the Psalms invariably help by giving me words in which I hear God and by which I can speak to God. I can only hope the same for you in 2024.
