Throughout the Psalms, 'headings' will precede the text. Sometimes the heading supplies the author, makes a musical reference or names the event that provoked the writing of the Psalm.

Such is the case here.

Psalm 18 is the longest, so far, in our journey through the Psalms. (six days, following the PCC Psalm Calendar). The heading teaches this Psalm was written by David and addressed to God in memory of his rescue "from all his enemies, and from the hand of Saul".

Flip over to 2 Samuel 22, you'll find the first version of Psalm 18. The two texts are almost identical. Why is this "Song of David" repeated?

Because we - God's people who worship Him today - embrace the grateful heart of David, too. In our King Jesus, we have been rescued from great peril, saved from the ruthless enemy and take eternal refuge in our God.



The roses on the altar are in honor of the 10 founding members of PCC. We remember them every January.
