**Sermon: Claiming the Uniqueness of God
from Romans 11.33-36**

Psalm 119.105-112

(a *responsive* reading)

One of the most famous phrases to come from Psalm 119 is found in today's reading. We are most familiar with the King James Version of 105: "Thy word is a lamp unto my feet, and a light unto my path." Michael W. Smith and Amy Grant used that first verse as the basis for a song released in 1984. "Thy Word", quickly found acceptance in congregational worship. Currently at least 22 hymnals include the song.

It's a good song. The Smith/Grant lyrics have certainly had the positive effect of planting God's Word into many hearts. Further, Grant's contribution - "Jesus be my guide, hold me to Your side, And I will love You to the end" - linked God's written Word to the "Word" Who "became flesh and dwelt among us". (John 1.14)

For our Call To Worship we will read, responsively, the entire section from verses 105-112. This section offers a challenge to all of us. Not only ought we extol the value of God's Word as a "light & lamp". Our challenge is to bind ourselves to it, to constantly remember it and find joy in following it "forever, to the end." (112)

That challenge can only be met by the methodical & consistent reading of God's Word. How often do you read Scripture? Listen to Scripture? Meditate and reflect upon Scripture? Actively apply Scripture? I both love and am humbled by God's calling in my life to teach Scripture. But I am not enough for you. No faithful pastor or excellent teacher will ever be enough for you. The Words we will say together will have their greatest impact upon your life if and when you and I personally put them into practice.
