Psalm 57.7-10

Psalms 56 & 57 provide most of the readings for this week. “A *Miktam* of David, when he fled from Saul, in the cave” is the heading for Psalm 57. (“*Miktam*” is used for Psalms 56-60.) These are Psalms of desperation AND dependence upon God.

1 Samuel 22.1-5 describes David on the run from Saul, gathering 400 men in a stronghold while making his family safe. David depended upon God for safety and ultimate victory.

Our Call to Worship is a *responsive* reading expressing David’s desire for God’s glory to be known.

They set a net for my steps;
my soul was bowed down.

They dug a pit in my way,
but they have fallen into it themselves.

*My heart is steadfast, O God,
my heart is steadfast!*

I will sing and make melody!

Awake, my glory!

Awake, O harp and lyre!

I will awake the dawn!

I will give thanks to You, O Lord, among the peoples;

I will sing praises to You among the nations.

For Your steadfast love is great to the heavens,

Your faithfulness to the clouds.
